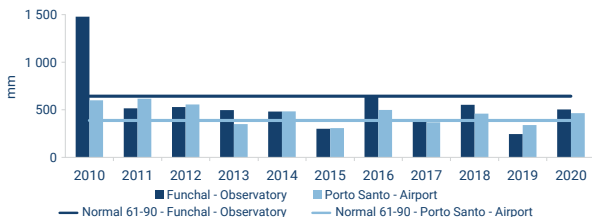

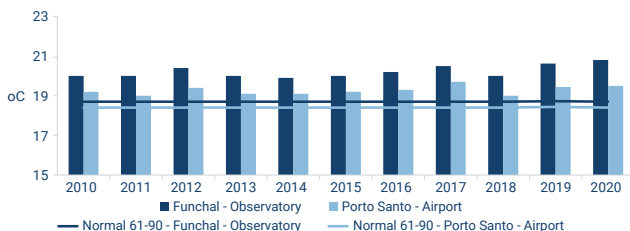

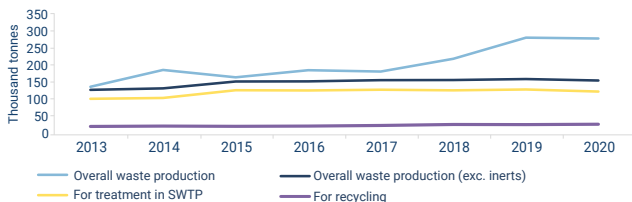

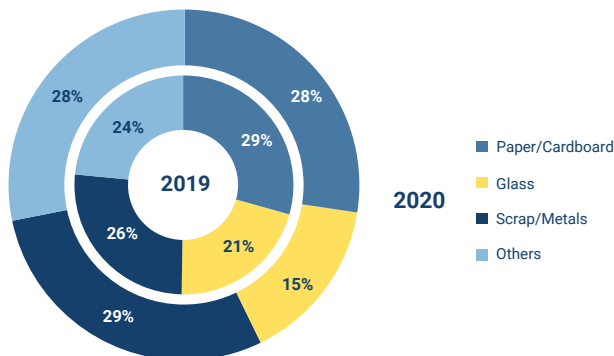

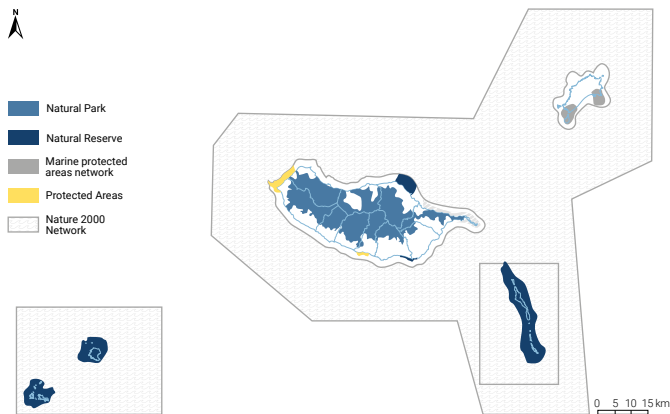

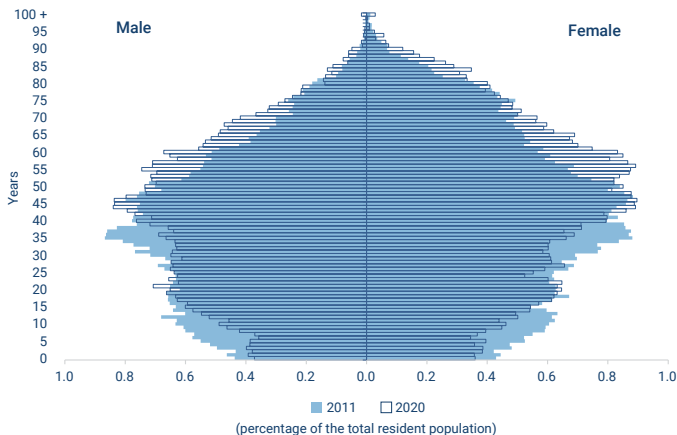

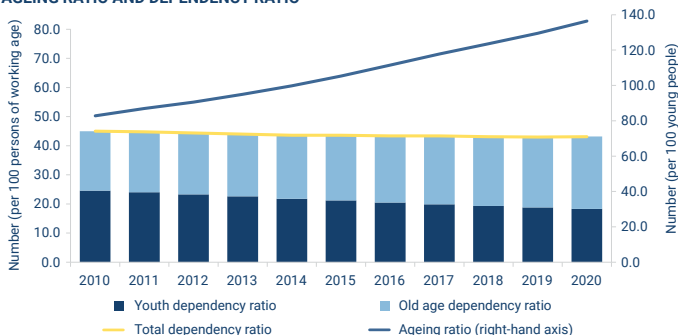

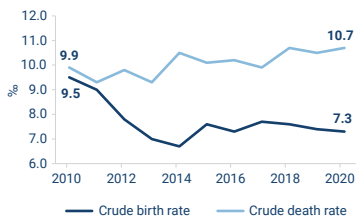

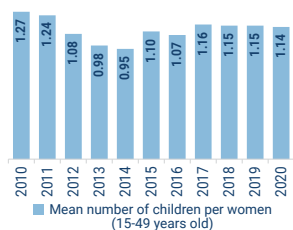

CRUDE BIRTH AND DEATH RATE

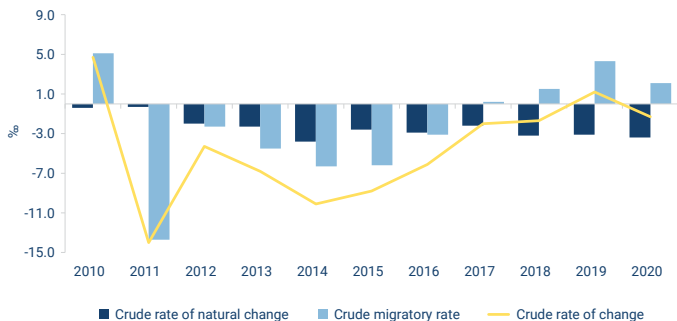


TOTAL FERTILITY RATE

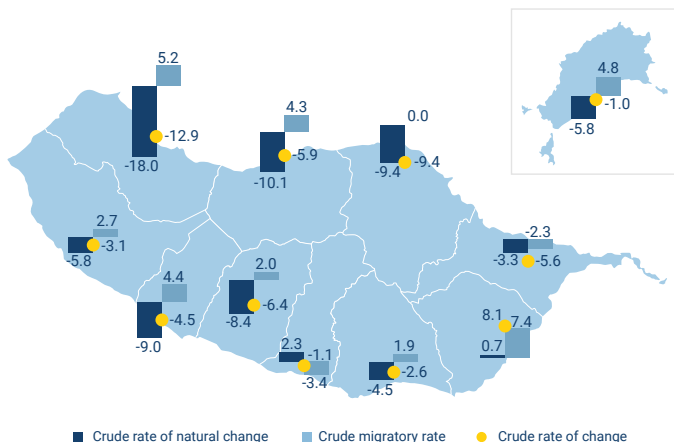

CRUDE RATE OF CHANGE, CRUDE MIGRATORY RATE AND CRUDE RATE OF NATURAL CHANGE



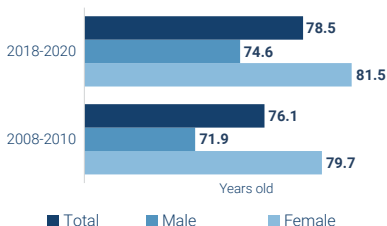
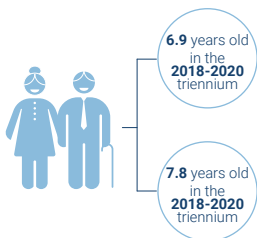

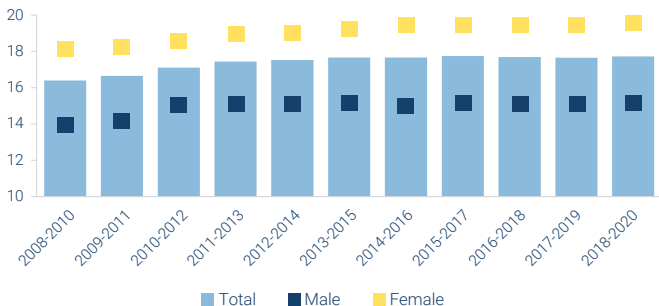

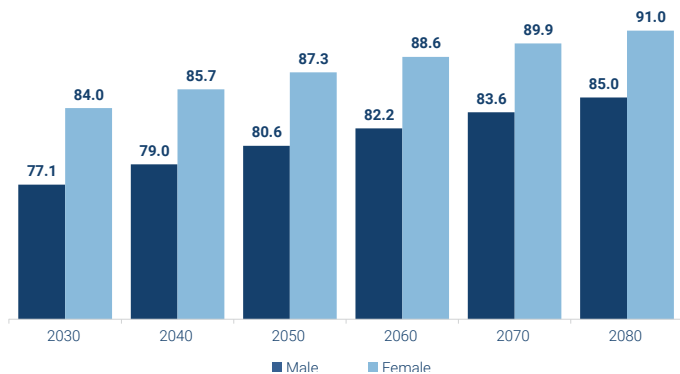

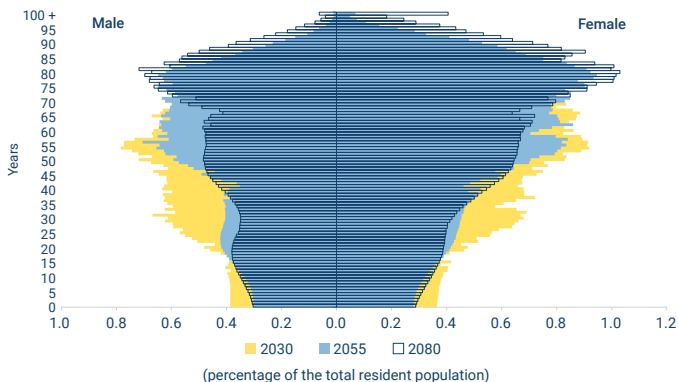

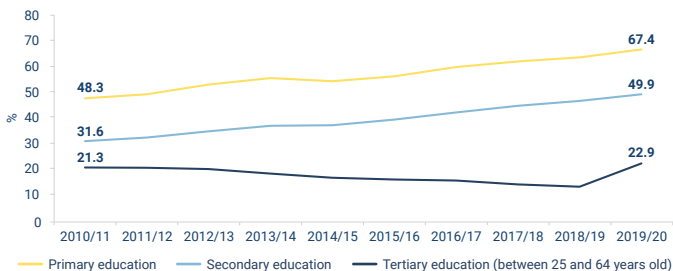

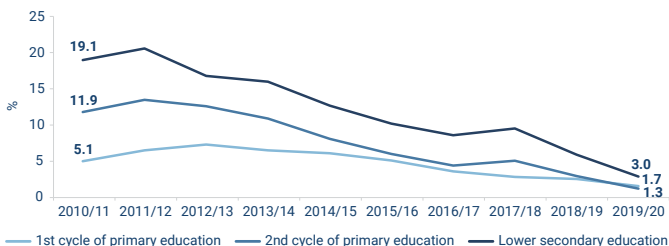

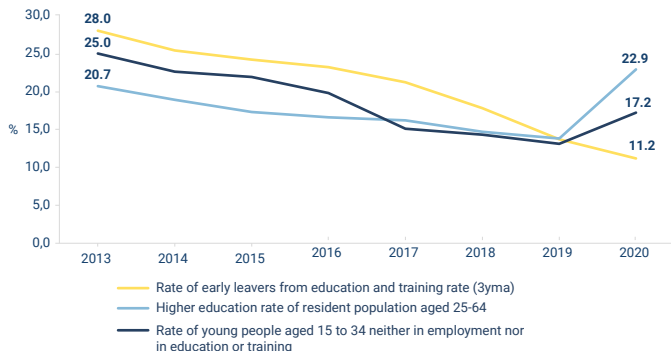

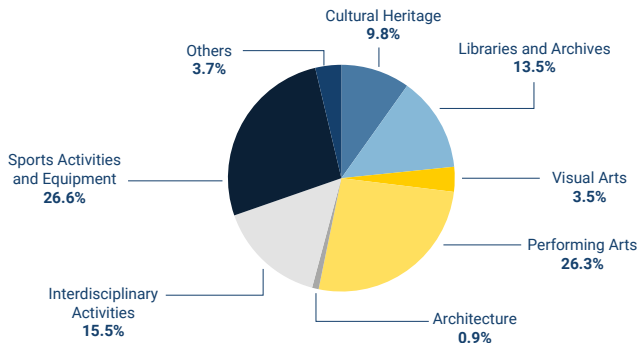

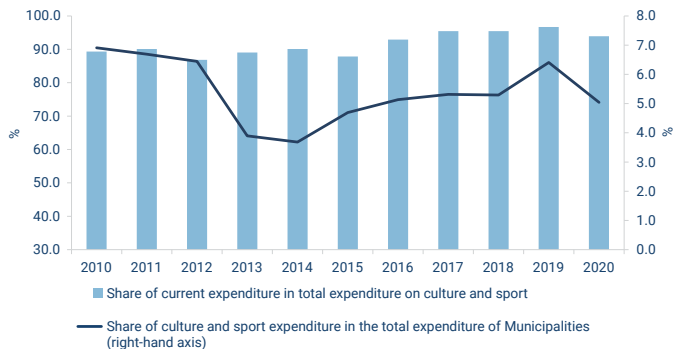

TOTAL EXPENDITURE OF MUNICIPALITIES ON CULTURAL AND SPORT ACTIVITIES, 2020

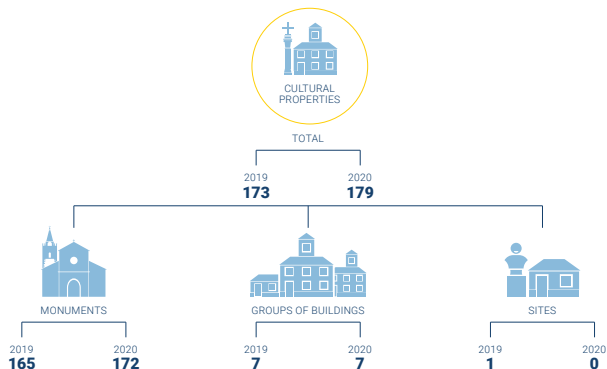

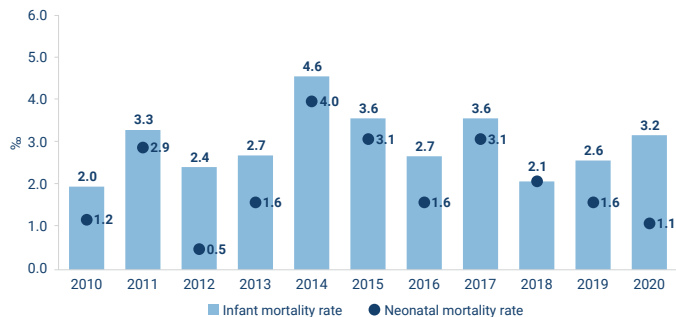

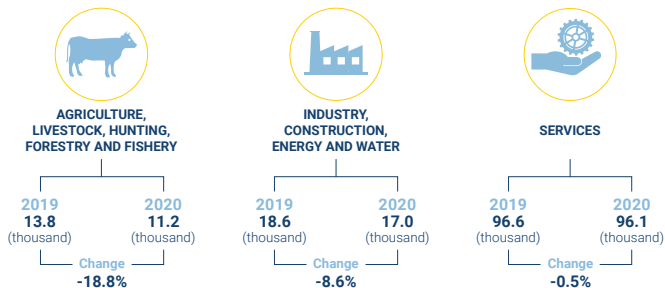

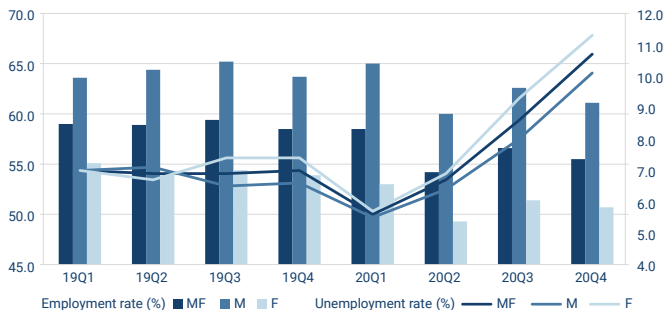

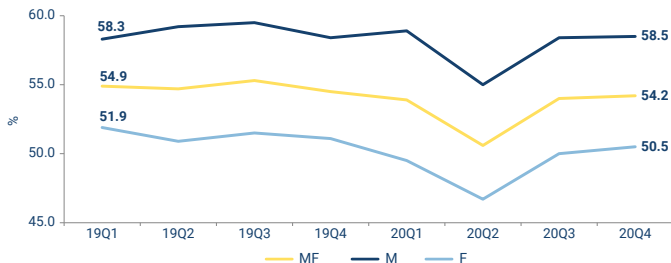

EMPLOYMENT AND UNEMPLOYMENT RATE, BY SEX

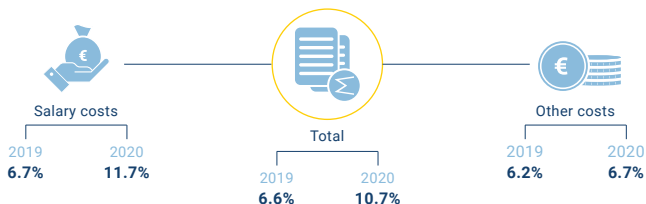


ACTIVITY RATE BY SEX

LABOUR COST INDEX (ANNUAL AVERAGE RATE OF CHANGE)



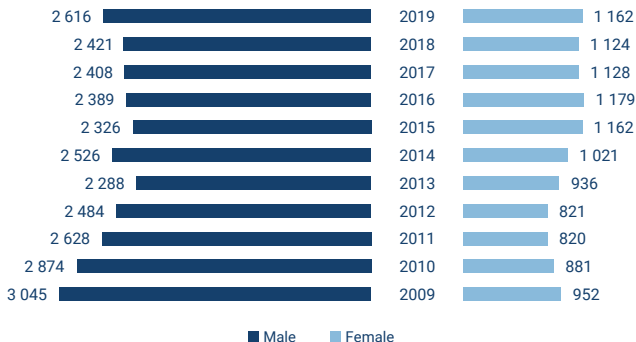

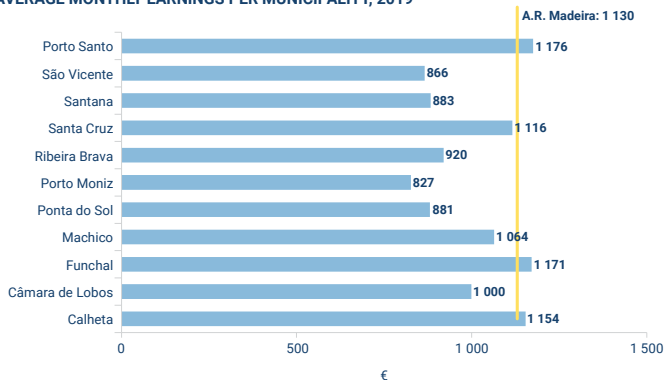

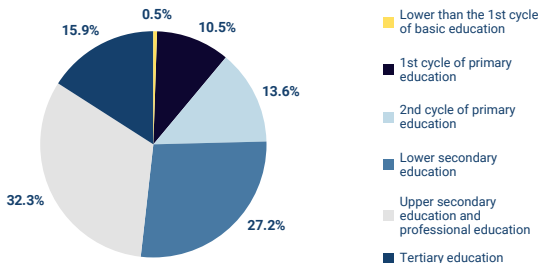

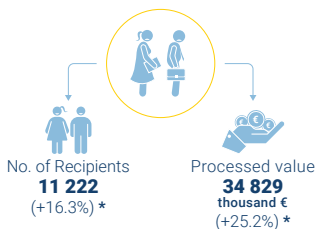

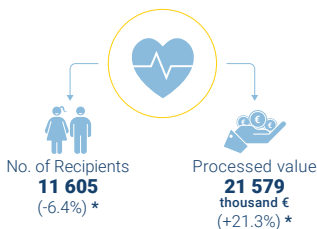

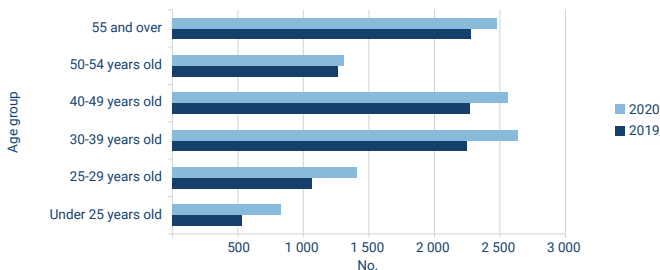

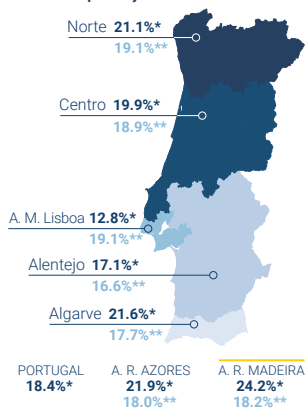

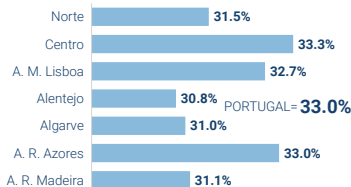

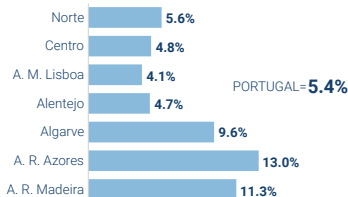

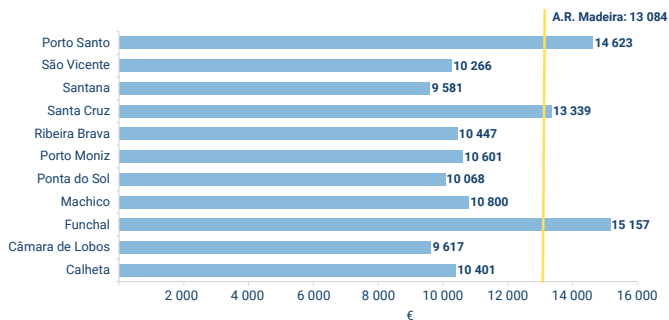

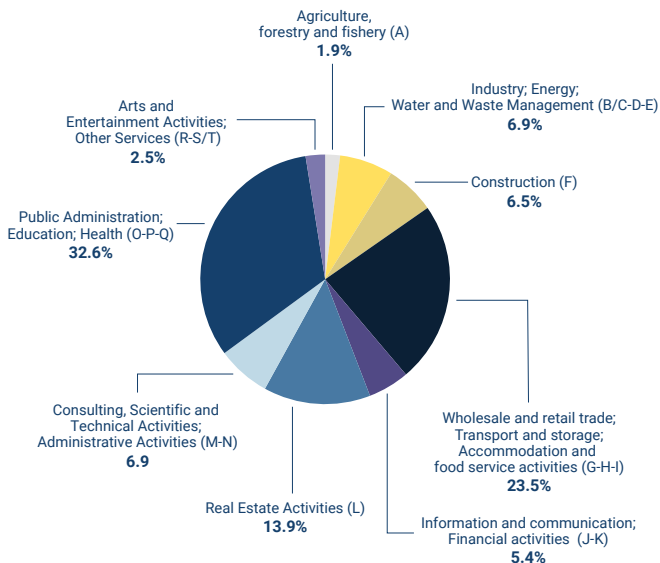

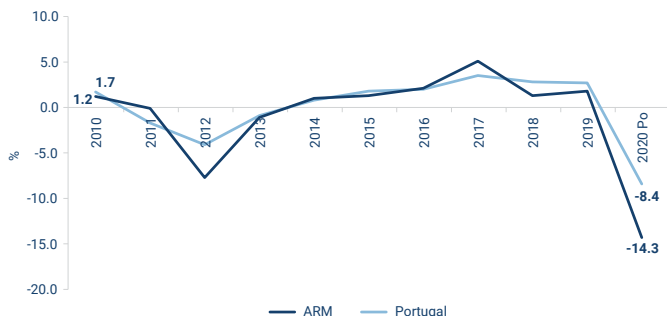

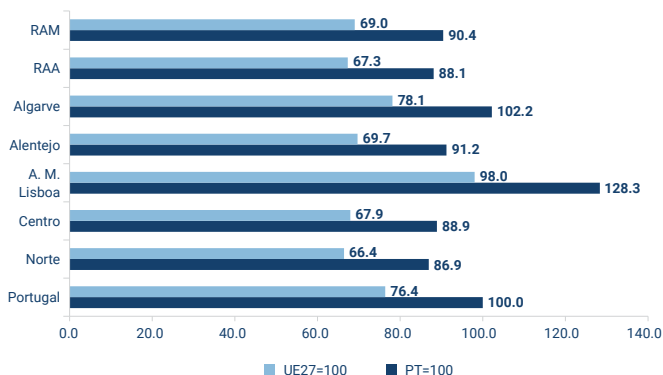

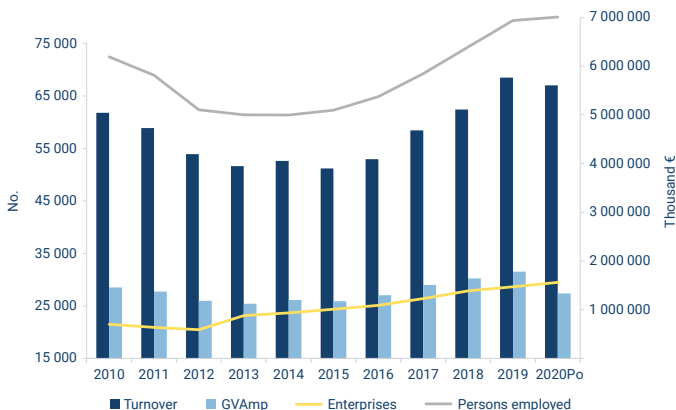

NON-FINANCIAL ESTABLISHMENTS BY MUNICIPALITY, 2019



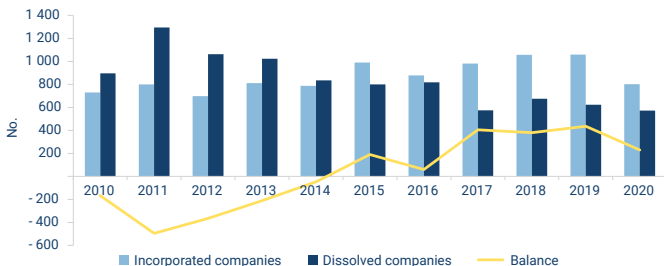

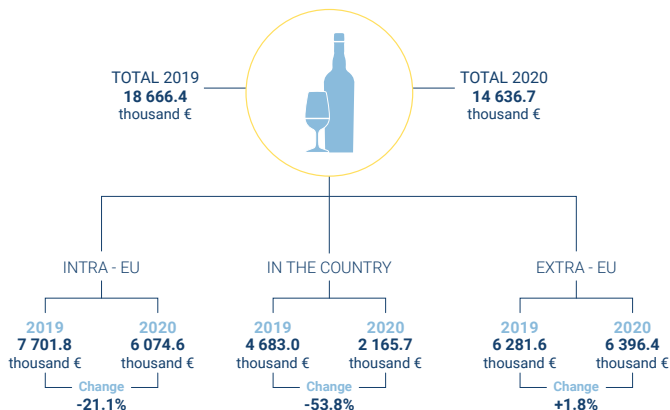

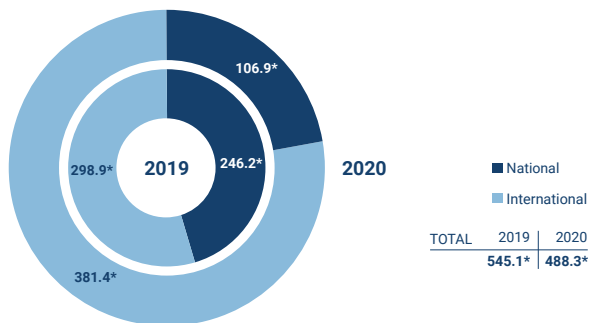

VALUE OF TRADED MADEIRA WINE, BY MARKET



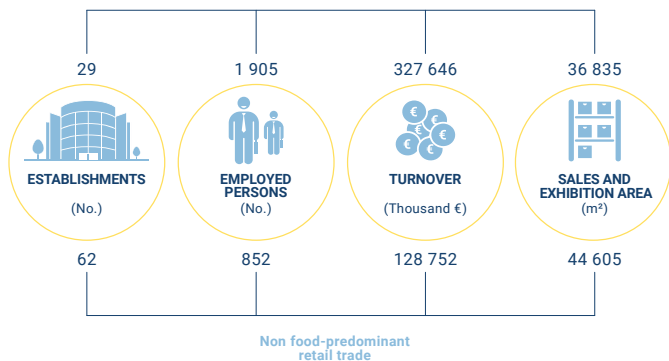

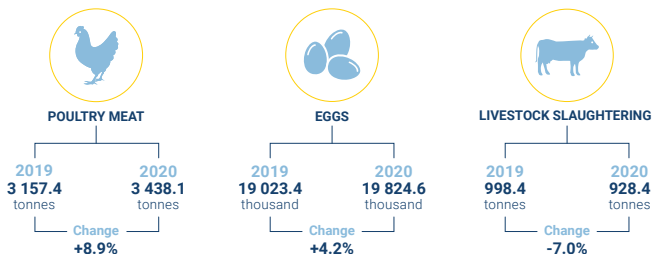

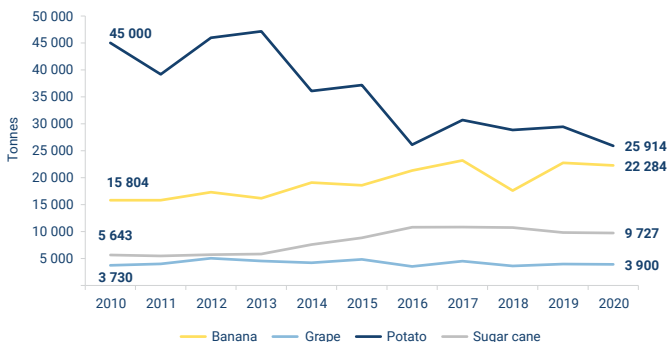

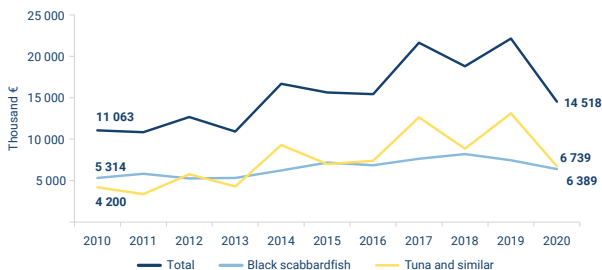

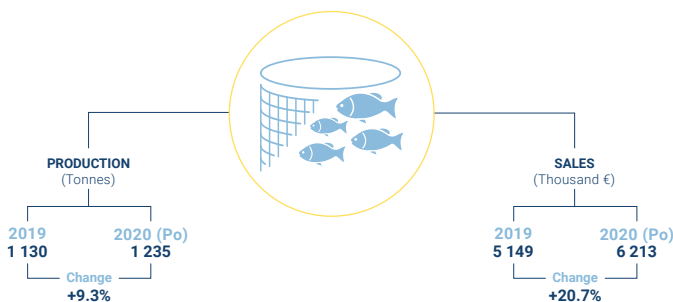

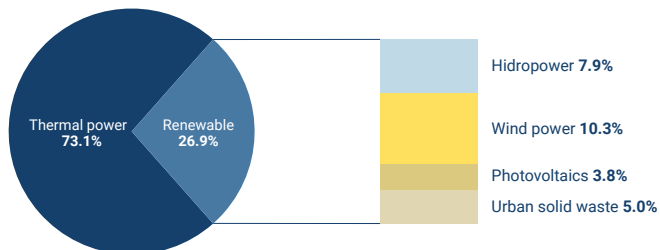

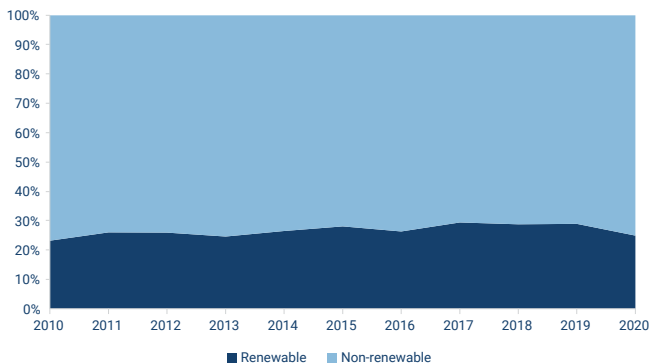

DISTRIBUTION OF ELECTRIC ENERGY, BY TYPE OF SOURCE



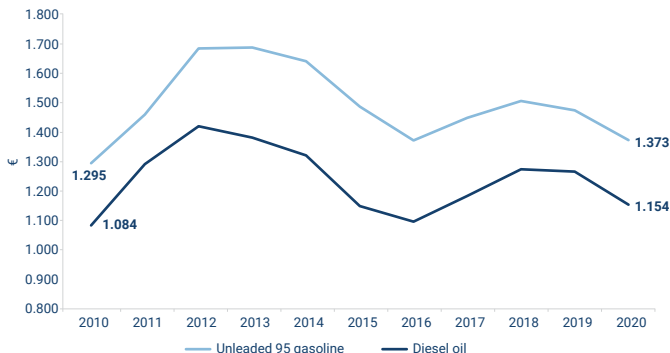

ANNUAL AVERAGE PRICE PER LITRE OF THE MAIN FUELS



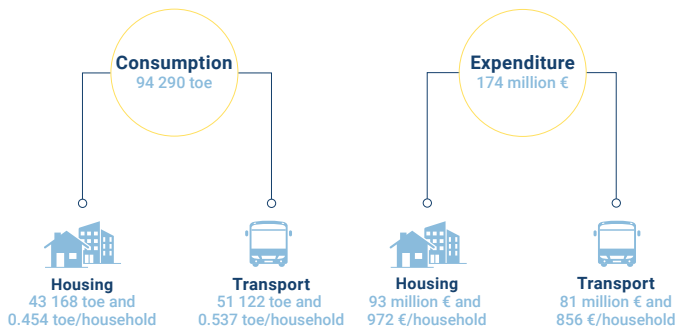

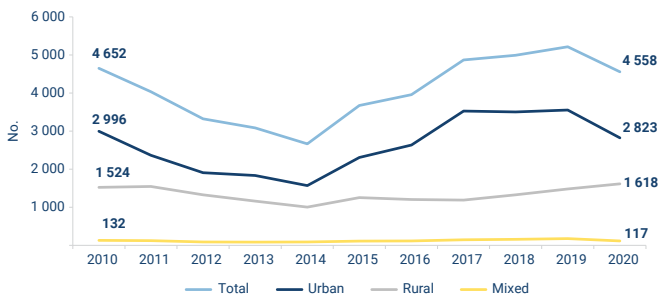

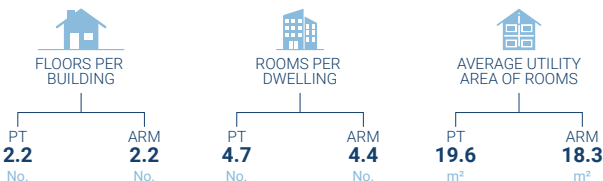

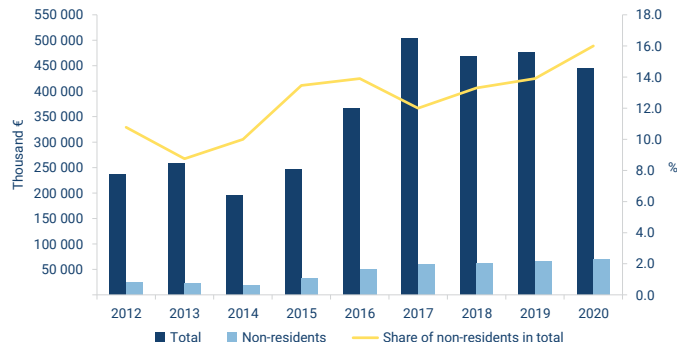

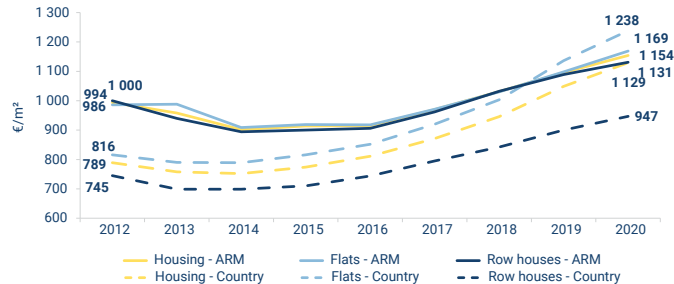

VALUE OF TRADED REAL ESTATE - TOTAL AND ACQUIRED BY NON-RESIDENT FOREIGNERS



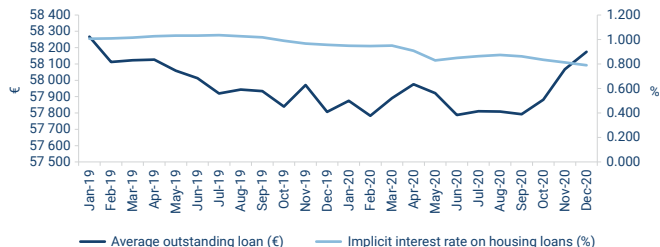

AVERAGE OUTSTANDING LOAN AND IMPLICIT INTEREST RATE ON HOUSING LOANS, 2019 AND 2020



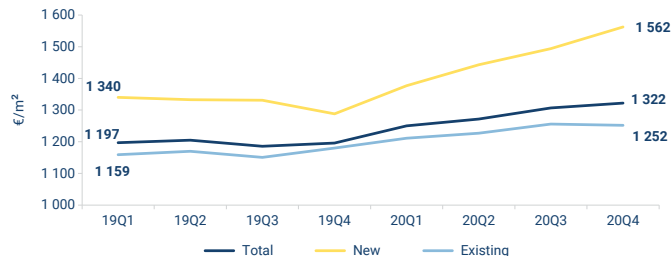

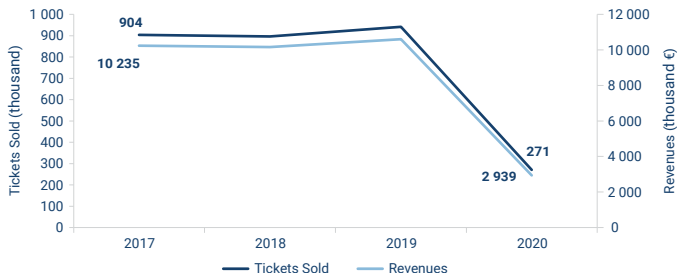

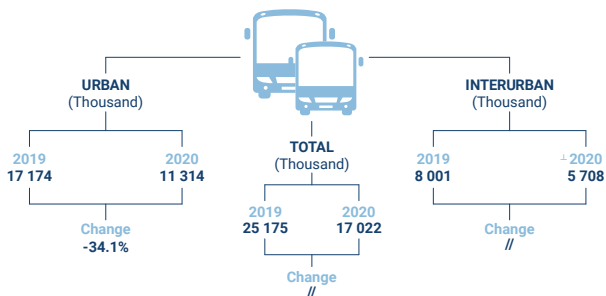

PASSENGERS TRANSPORTED BY BUS ACCORDING TO THE TYPE OF LINE



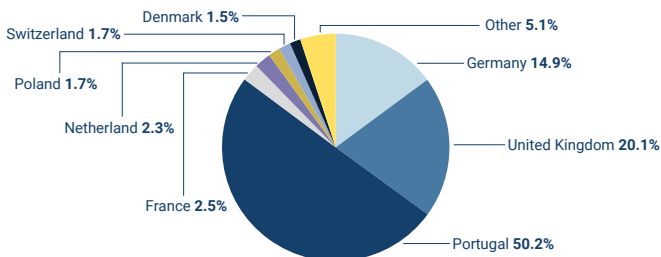

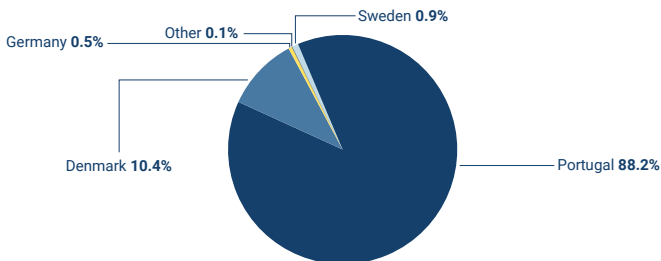

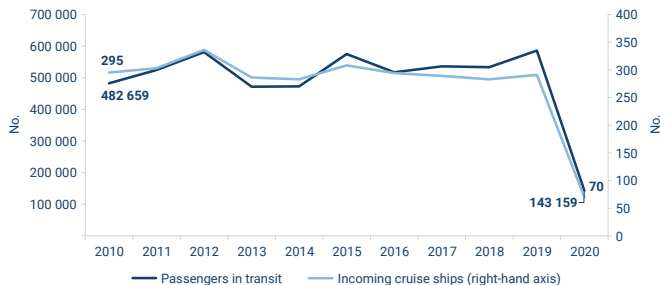

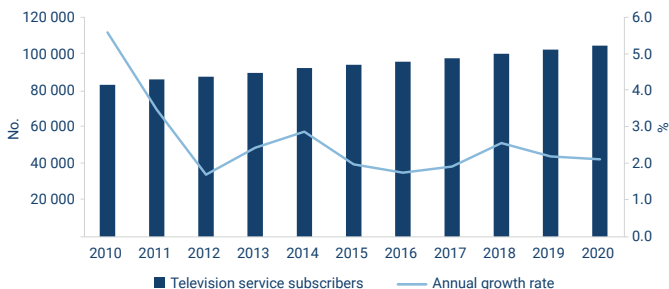

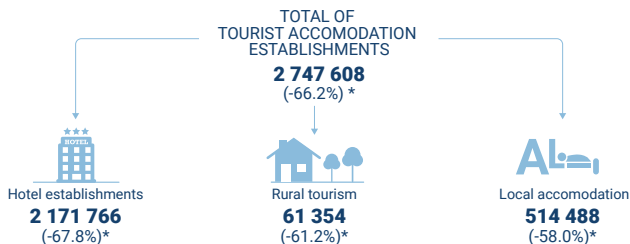

OVERNIGHT STAYS BY MUNICIPALITY IN TOURIST ACCOMMODATION ESTABLISHMENTS



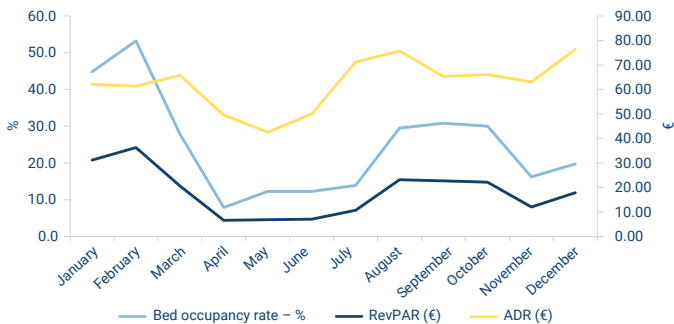

OVERNIGHT STAYS, BY TYPE OF ESTABLISHMENT, 2020

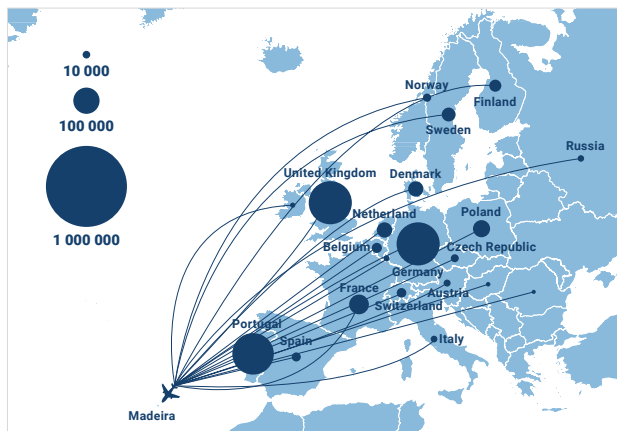

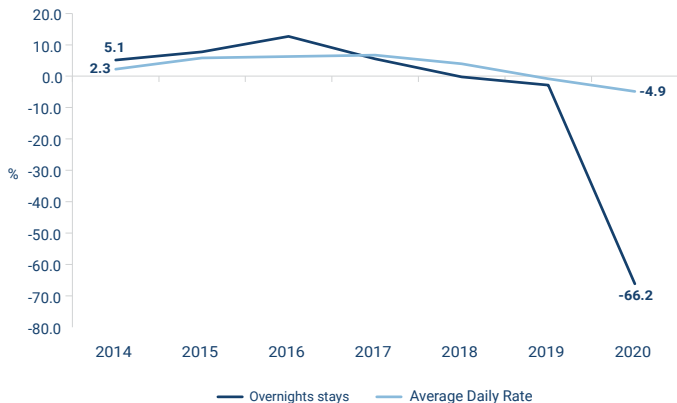

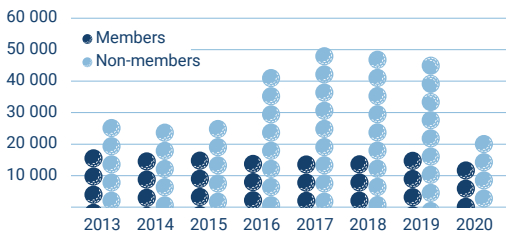

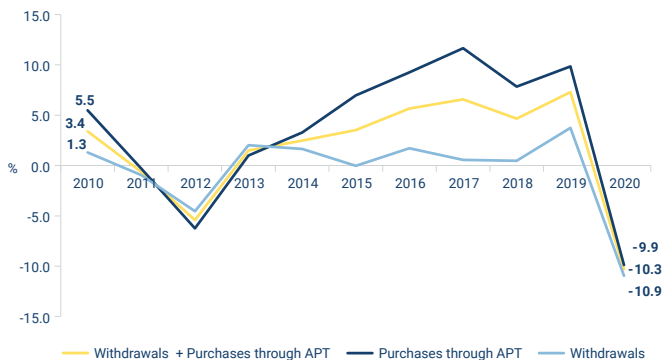

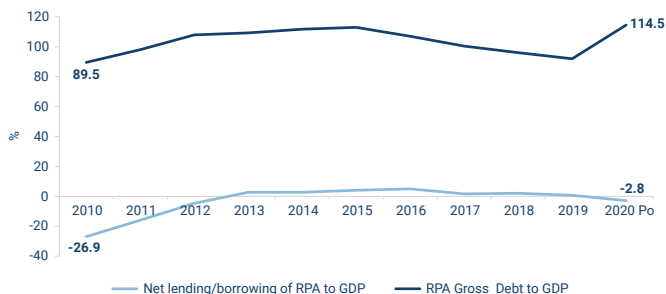

GROSS DEBT, 2020

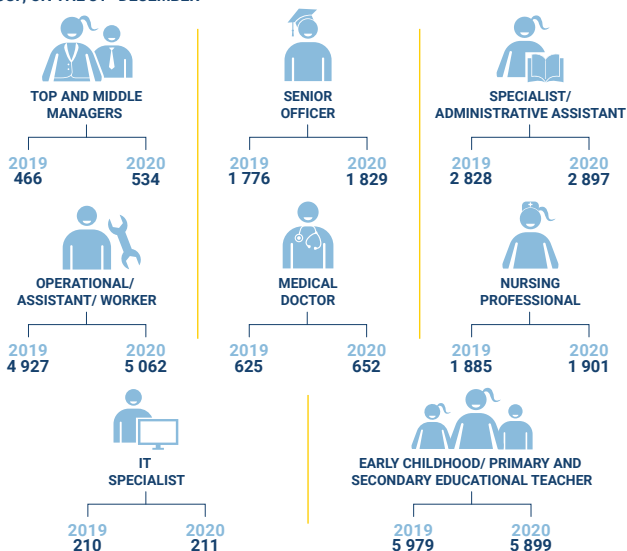

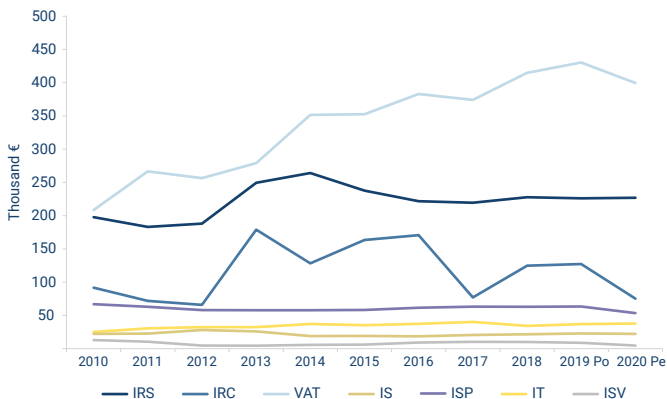
DISTRIBUTION OF JOBS BY AGE GROUP AND SEX ON THE 31st DECEMBER 2020

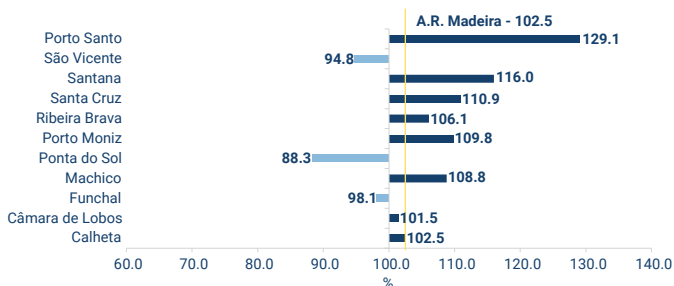

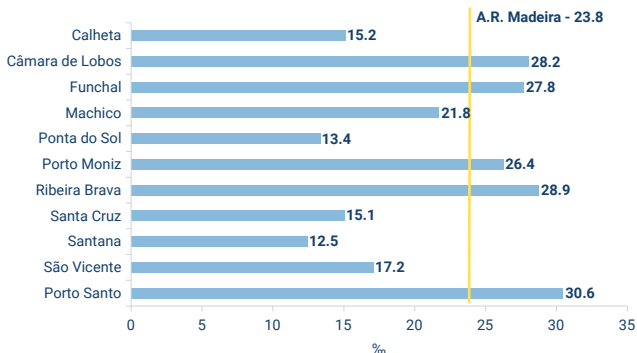

CRIME RATE BY MUNICIPALITY, 2020



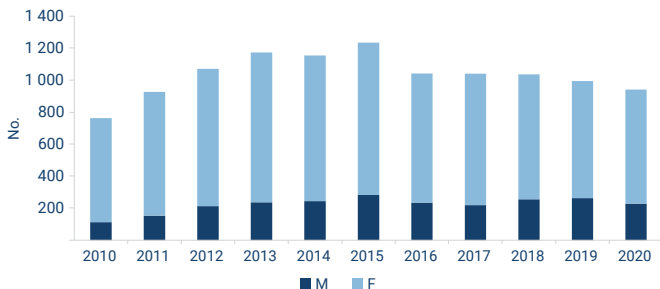
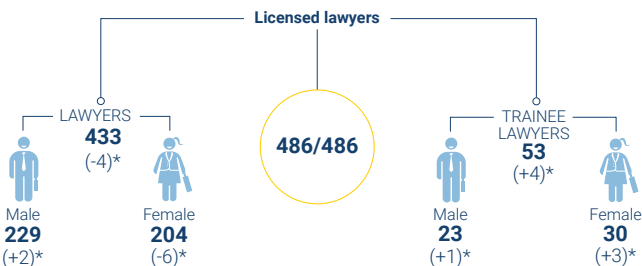

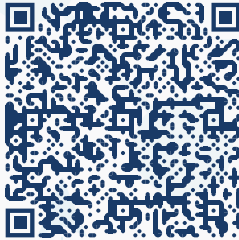
