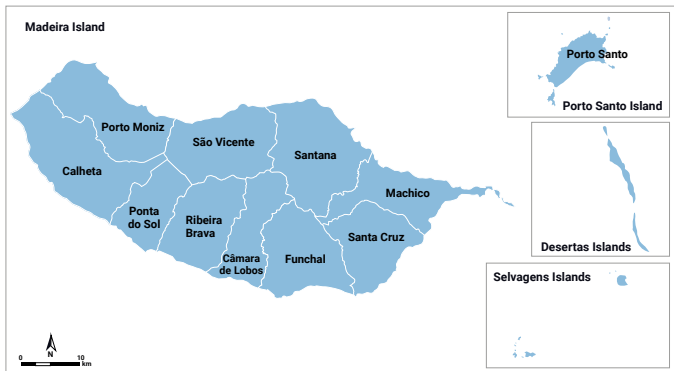

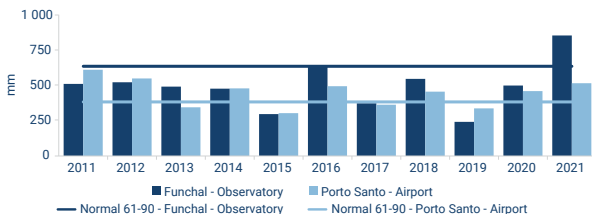

PRECIPITATION, BY METEOROLOGICAL STATION

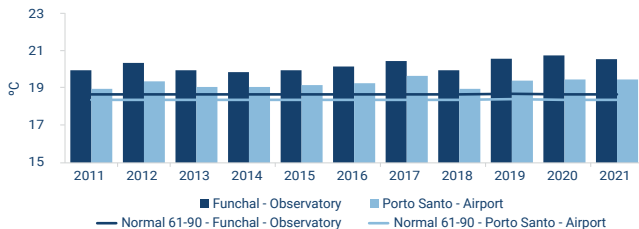

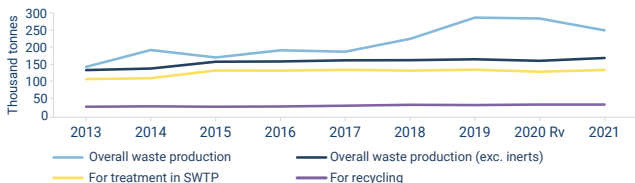

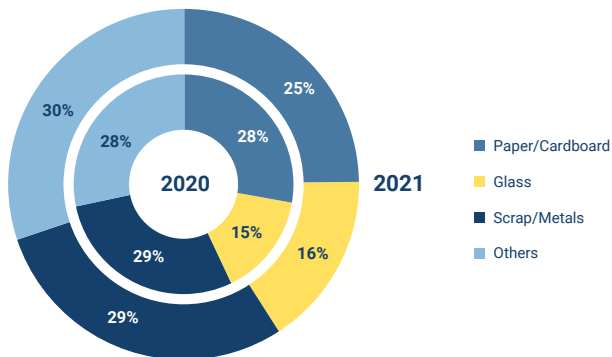

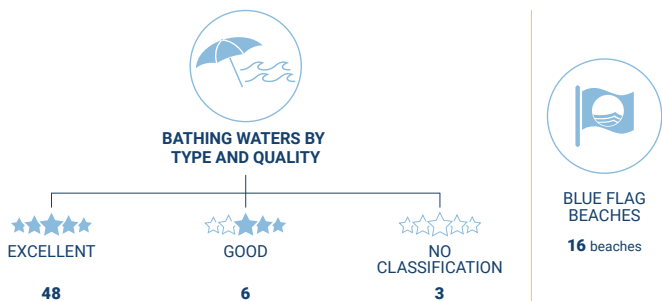

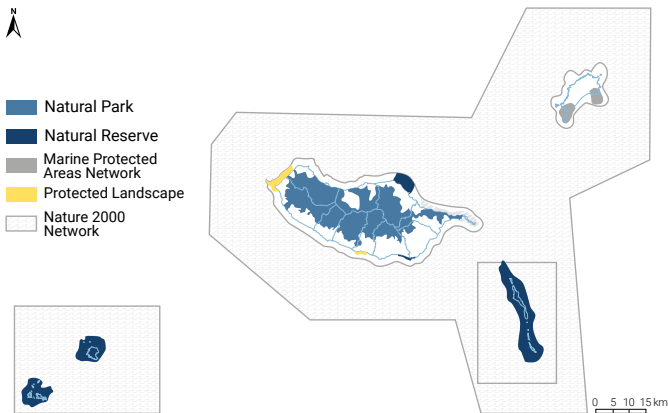

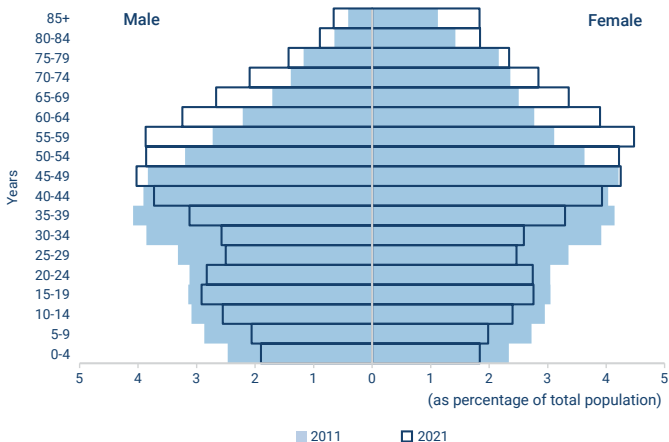

AGE STRUCTURE OF THE RESIDENT POPULATION, 2011 AND 2021

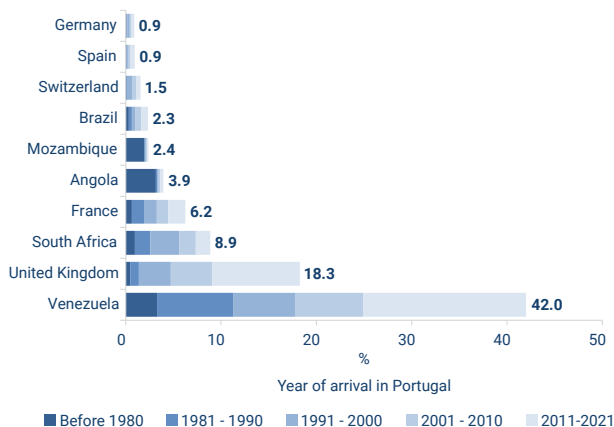

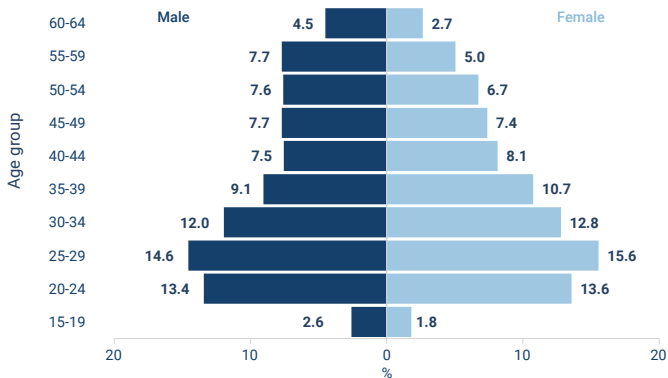

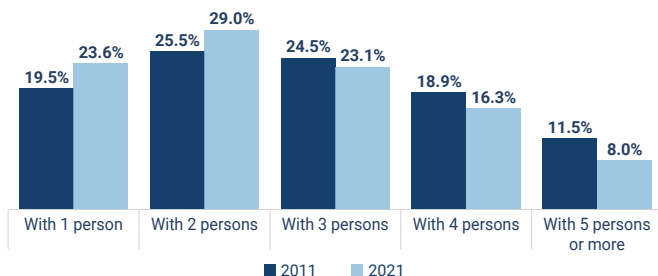

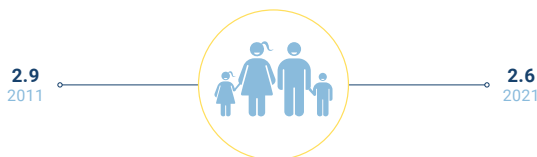

HOUSEHOLD SIZE OF PRIVATE HOUSEHOLDS



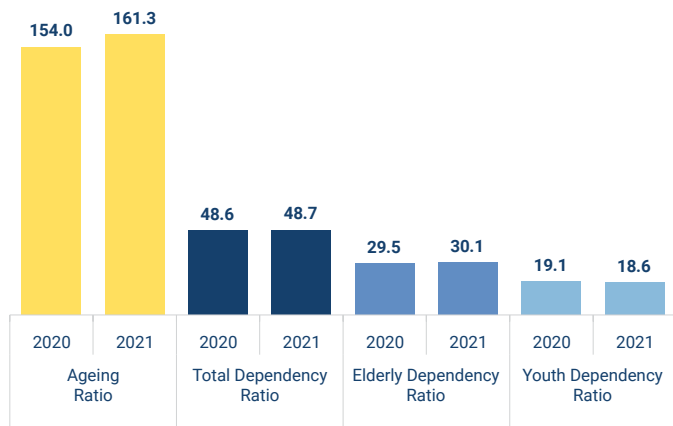

AGEING RATIO AND DEPENDENCY RATIOS


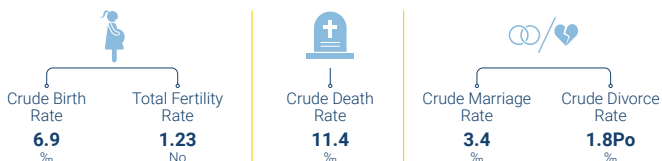

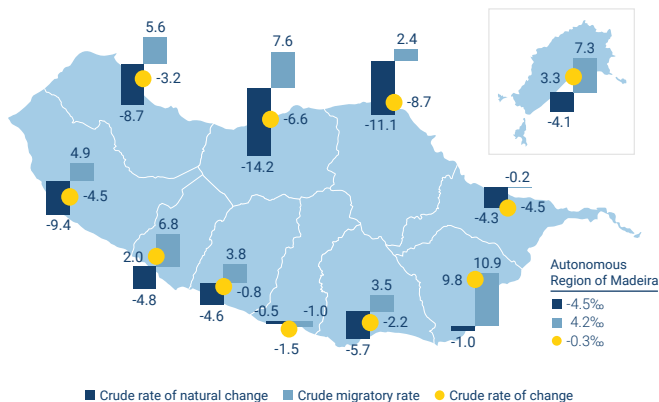

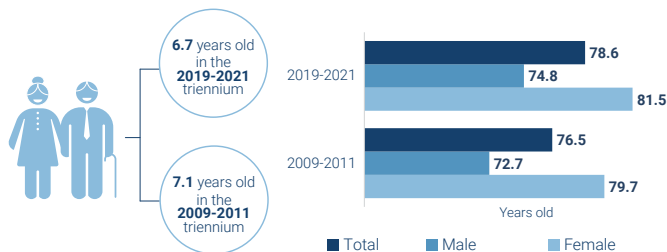

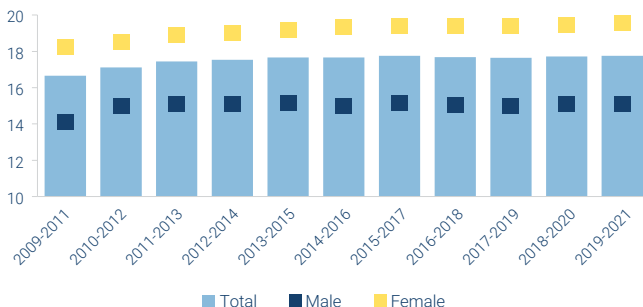
LIFE EXPECTANCY AT BIRTH

The gap between male and female has narrowed:



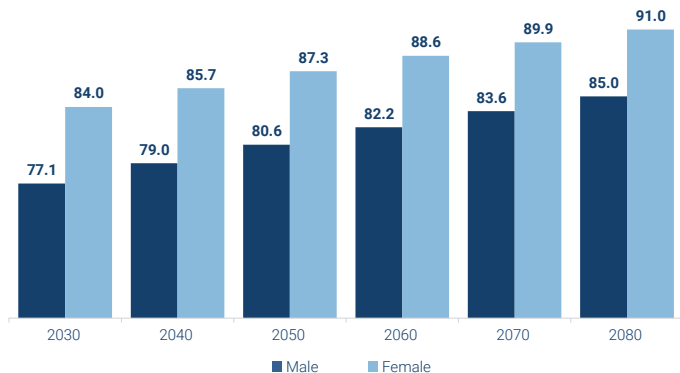
LIFE EXPECTANCY AT 65 YEARS OF AGE

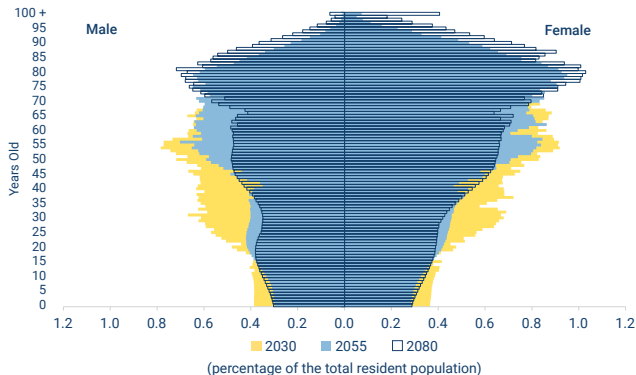

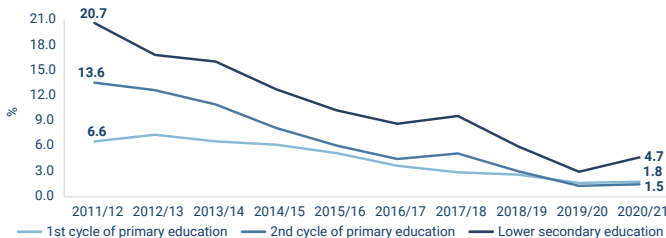

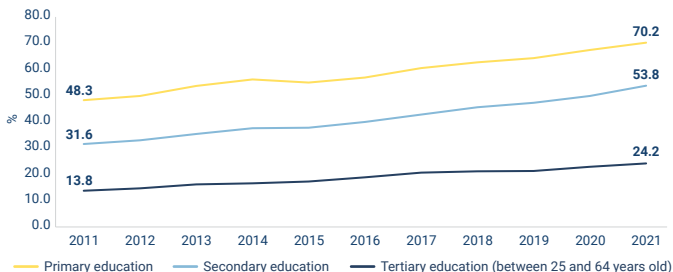

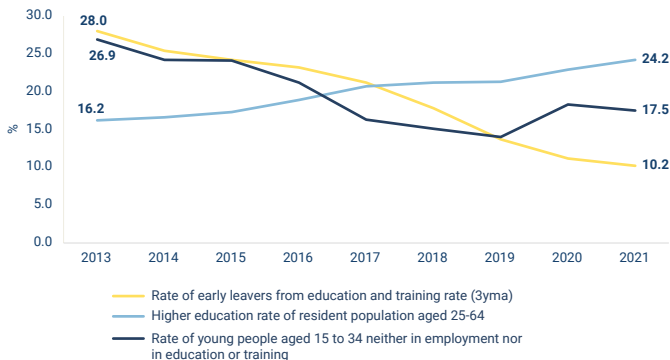

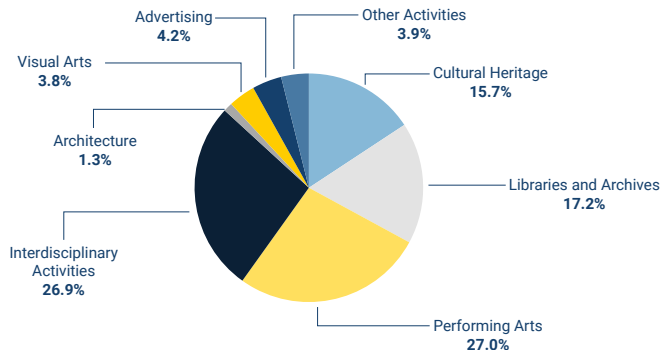

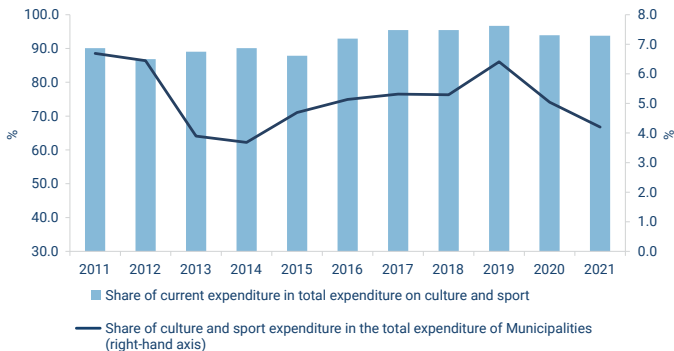

TOTAL EXPENDITURE OF MUNICIPALITIES ON CULTURAL AND CREATIVE ACTIVITIES, 2021

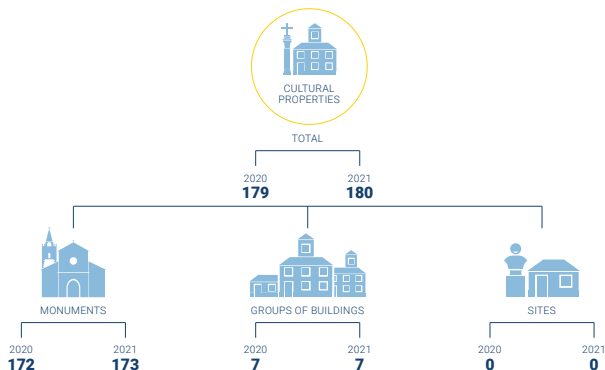

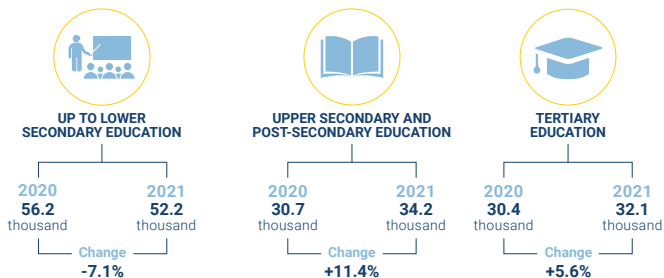

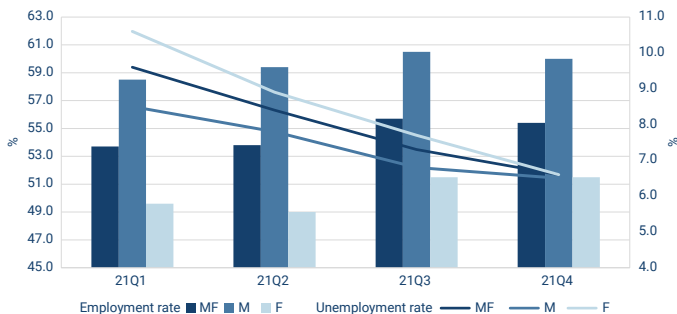

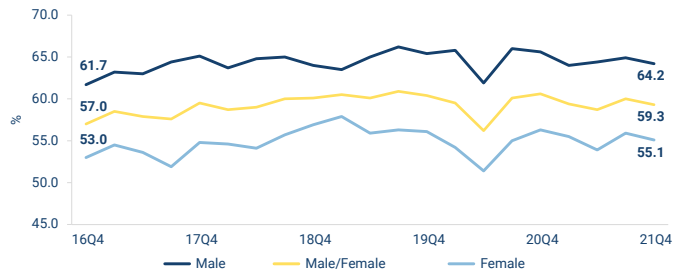

ACTIVITY RATE, BY SEX

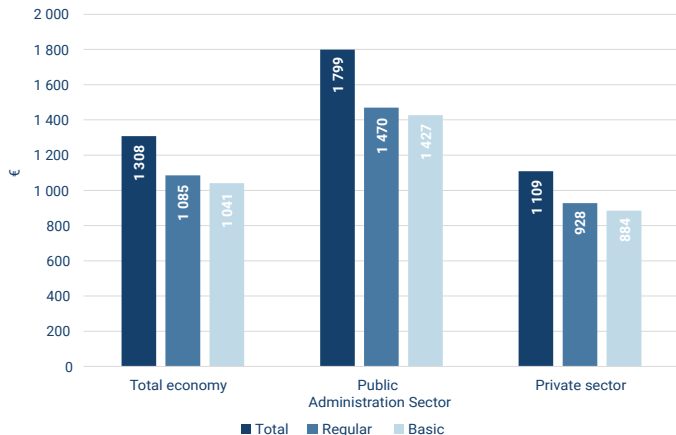

GROSS MONTHLY EARNINGS PER EMPLOYEE

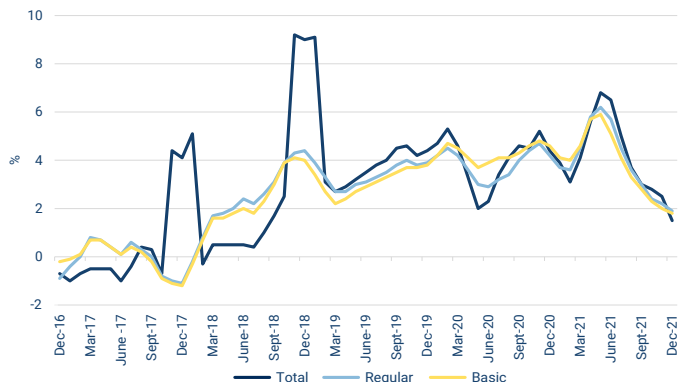

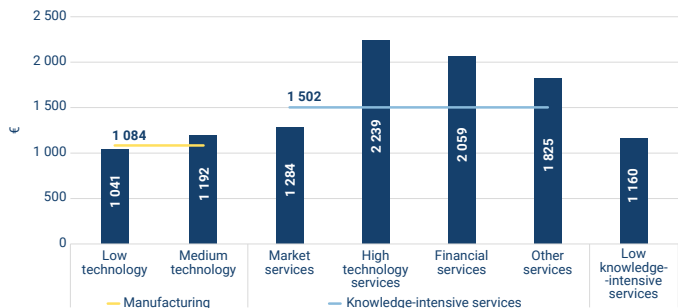

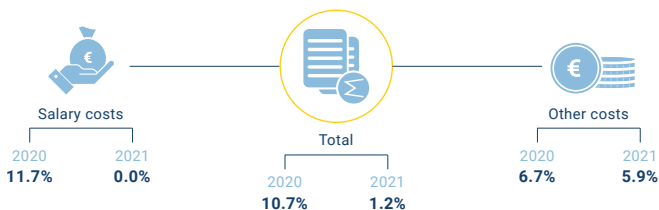

LABOUR COST INDEX (ANNUAL AVERAGE RATE OF CHANGE)



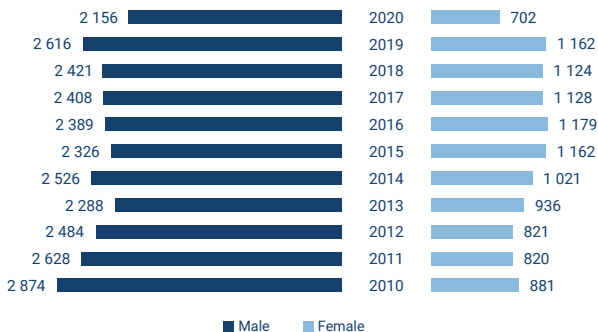

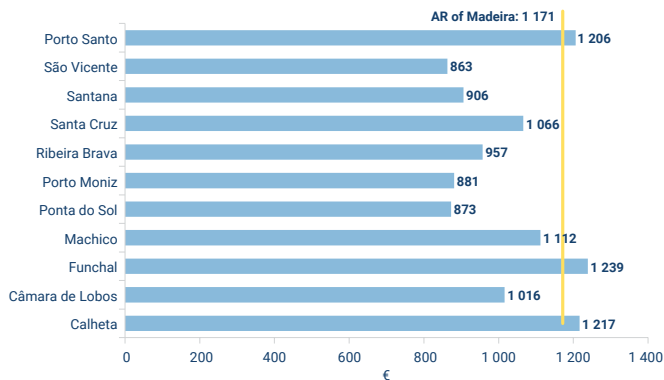

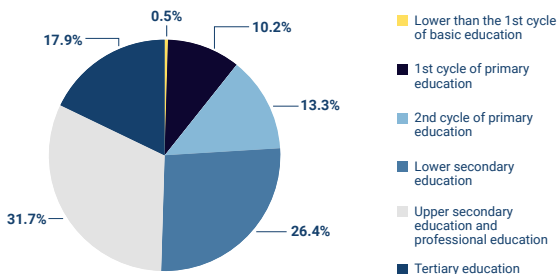

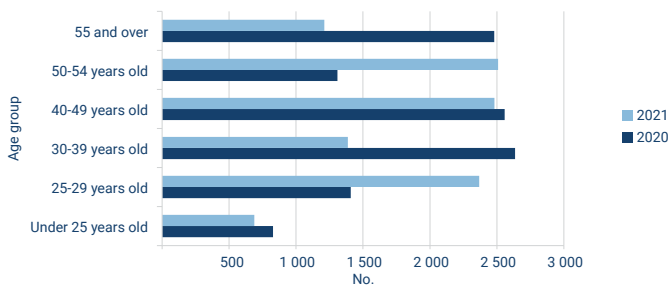

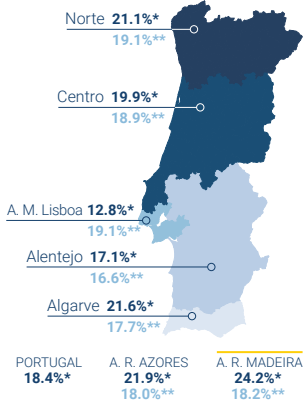

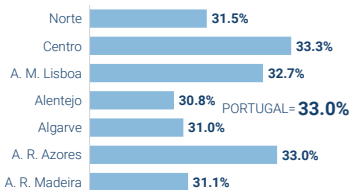

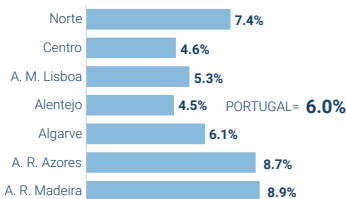

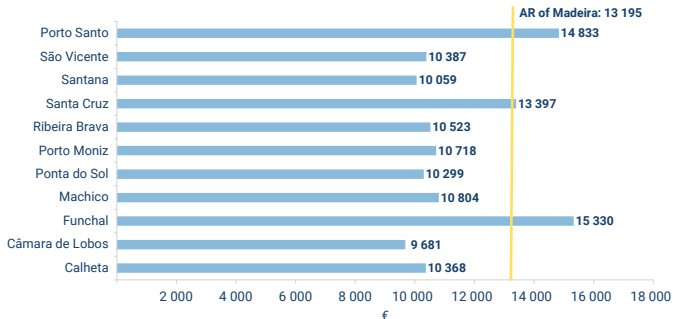

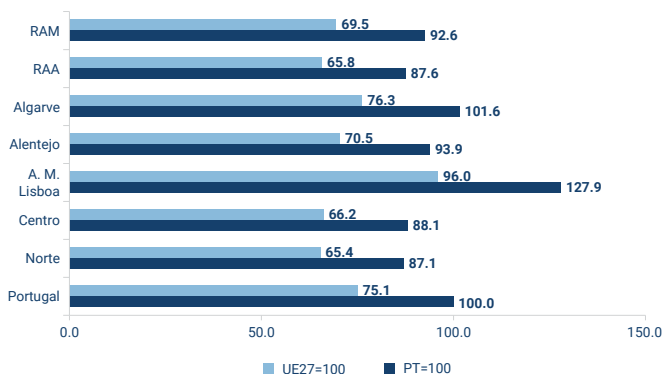

CONSUMER PRICES INDEX, AVERAGE CHANGE IN THE LAST 12 MONTHS



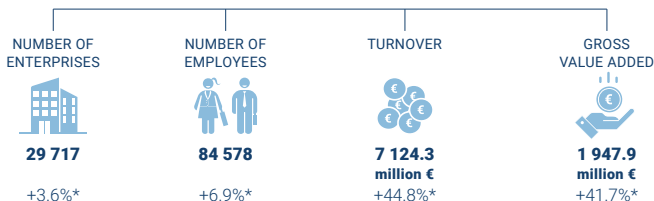

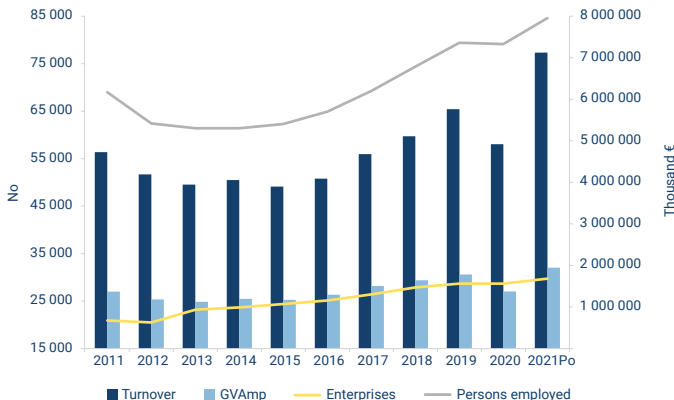

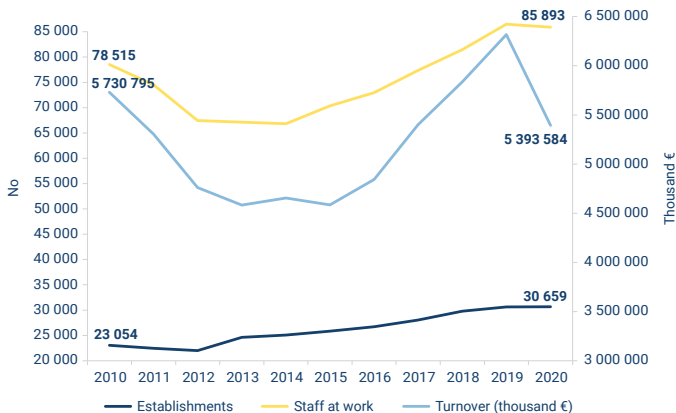

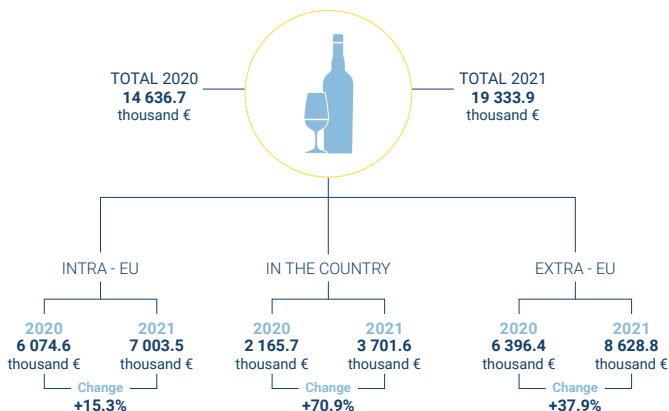

VALUE OF TRADED MADEIRA WINE, BY MARKET

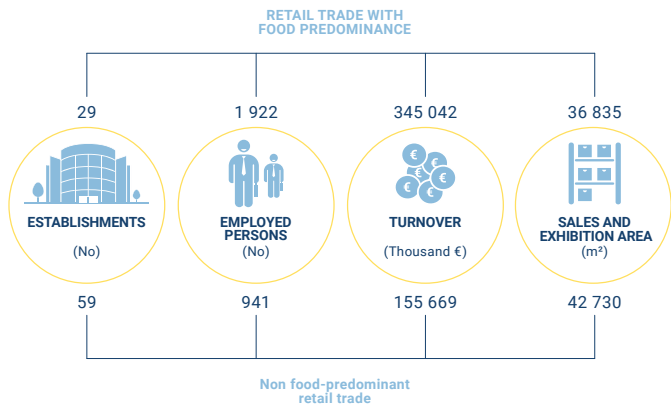

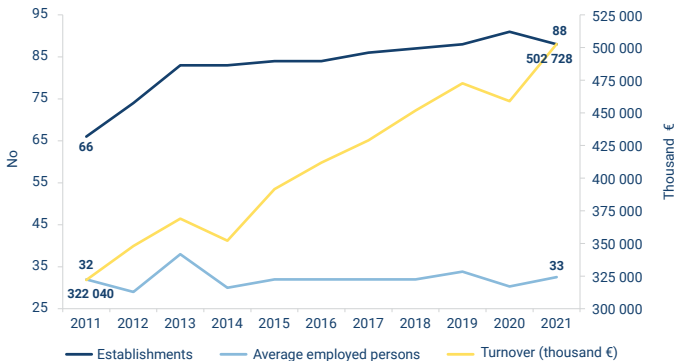

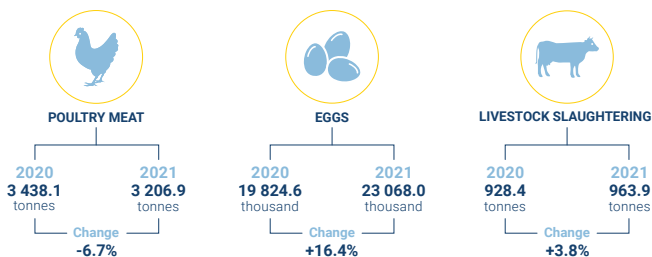

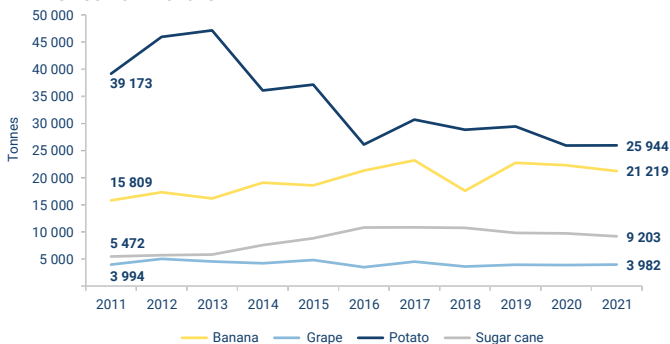

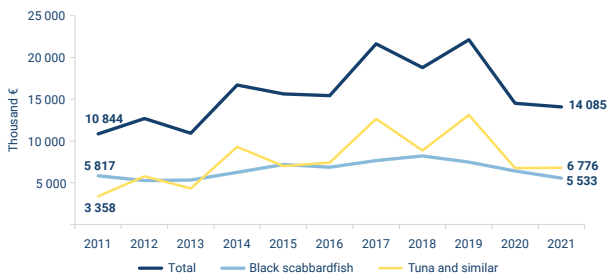

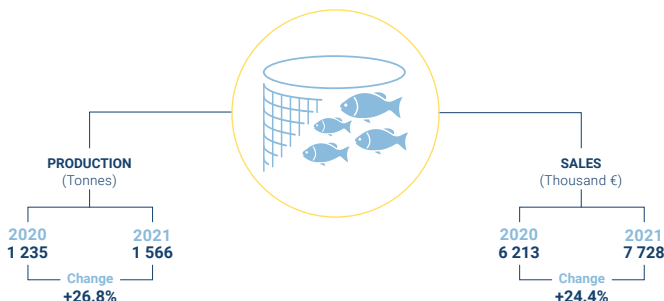

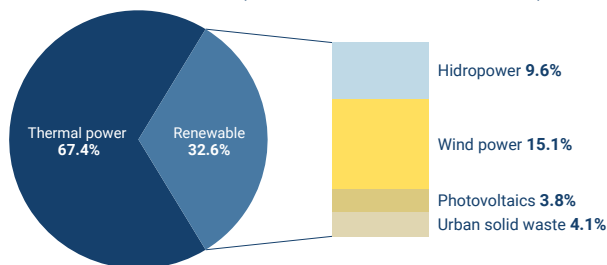

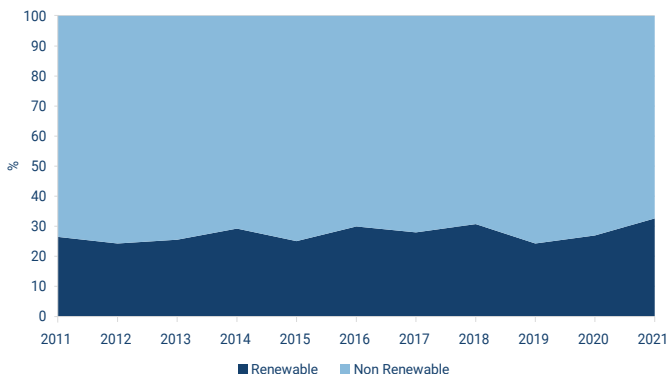

DISTRIBUTION OF ELECTRIC ENERGY, BY TYPE OF SOURCE



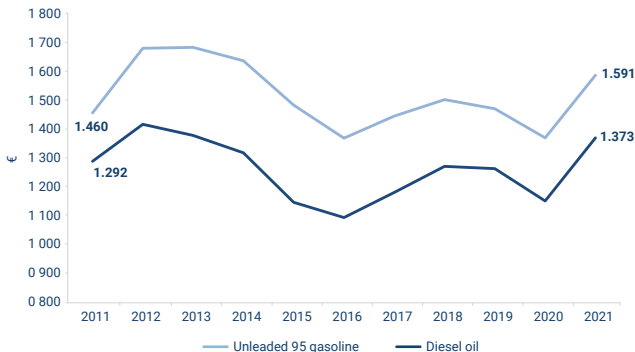

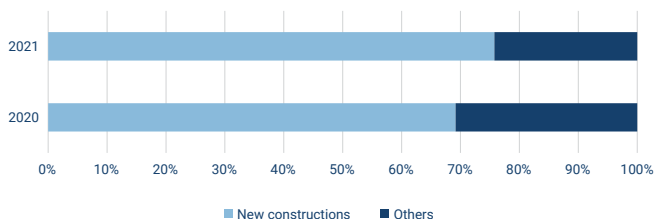

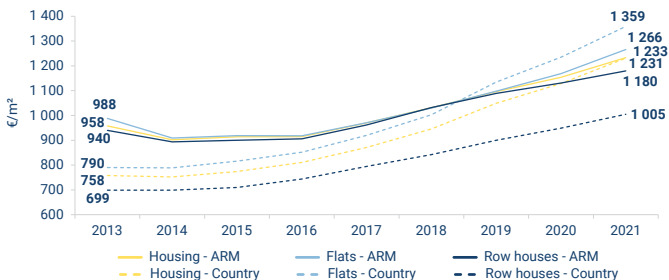

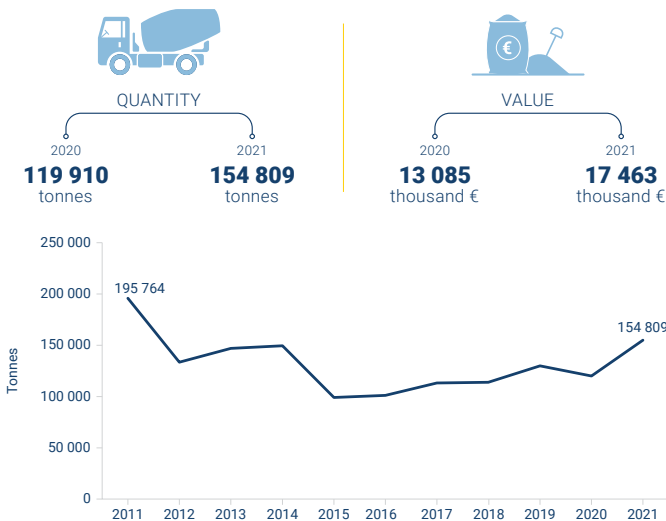

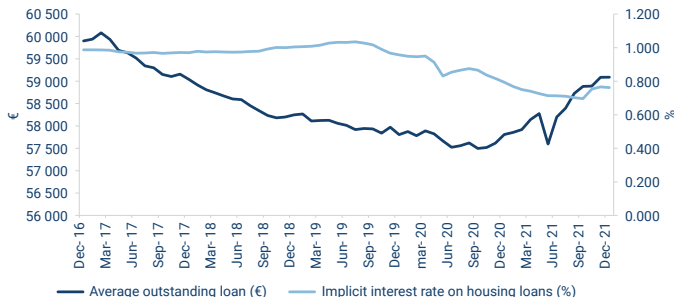

AVERAGE OUTSTANDING LOAN AND IMPLICIT INTEREST RATE ON HOUSING LOANS, 2020 AND 2021

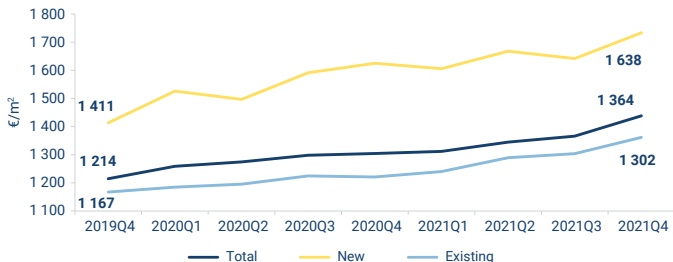

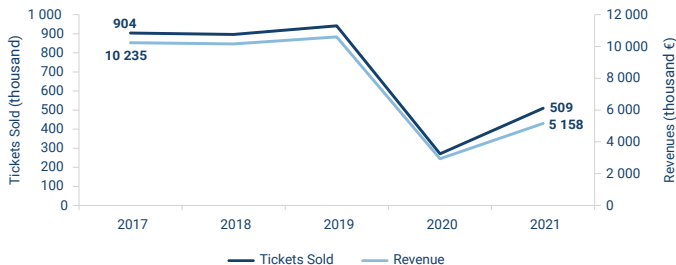

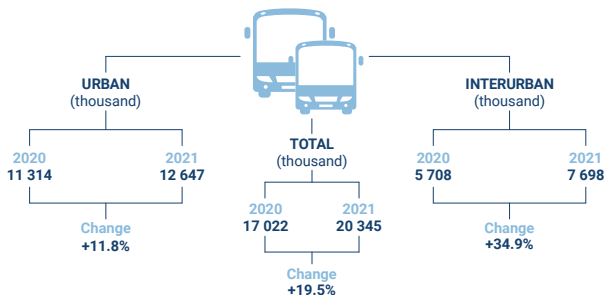

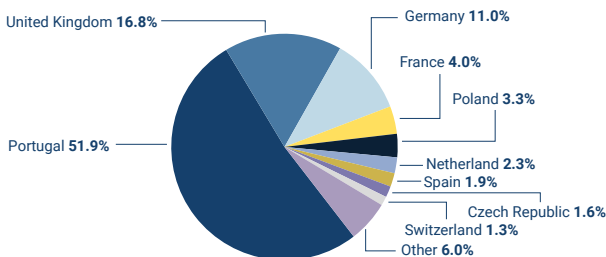

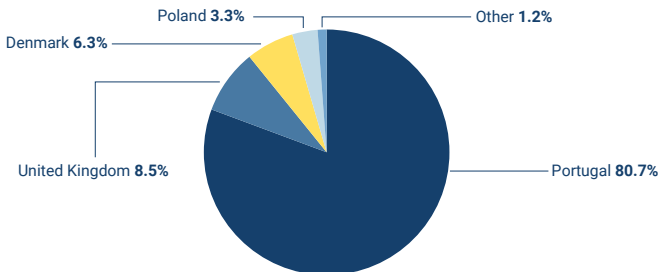

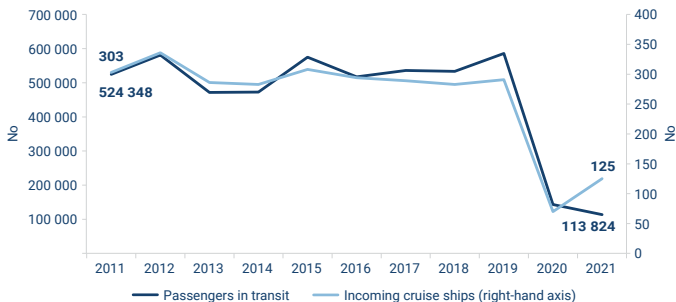

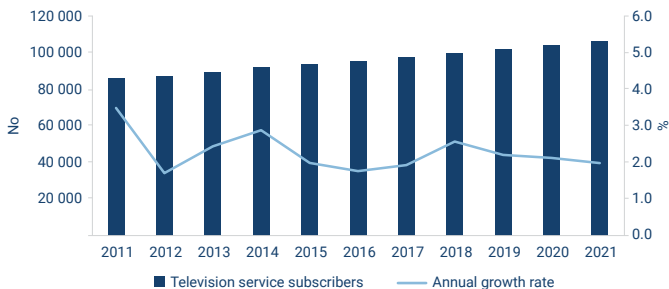

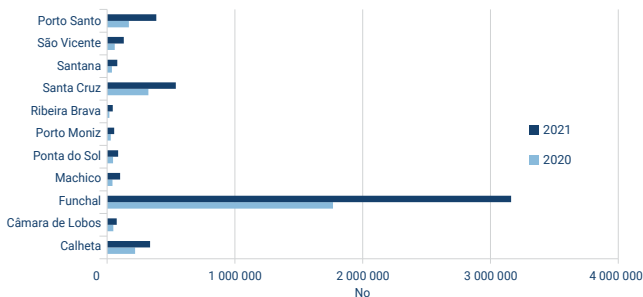

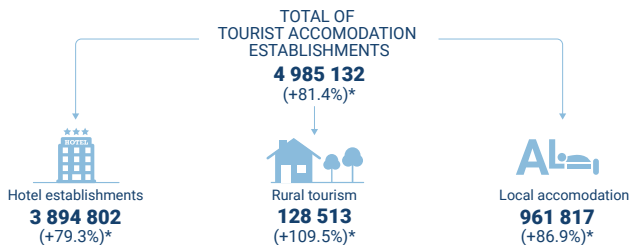

OVERNIGHT STAYS IN TOURIST ACCOMMODATION ESTABLISHMENTS BY MUNICIPALITY



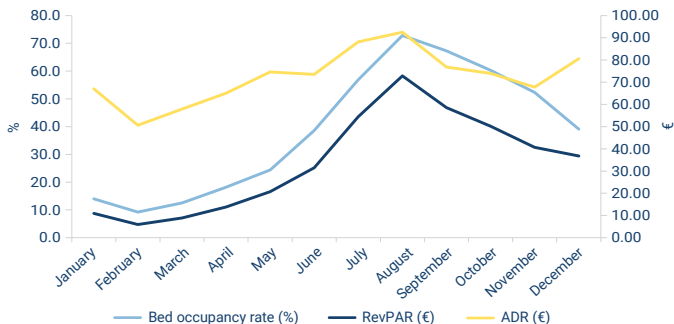

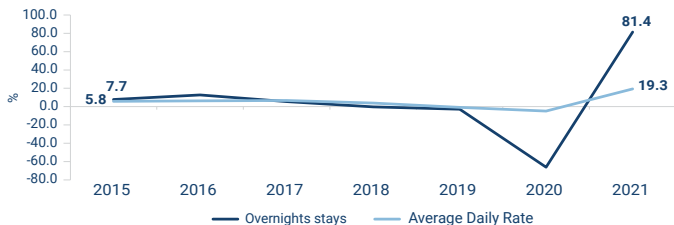

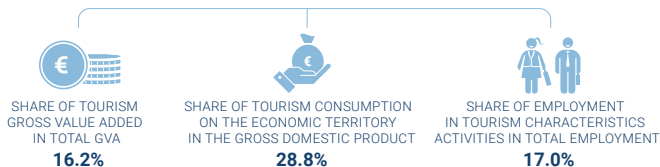

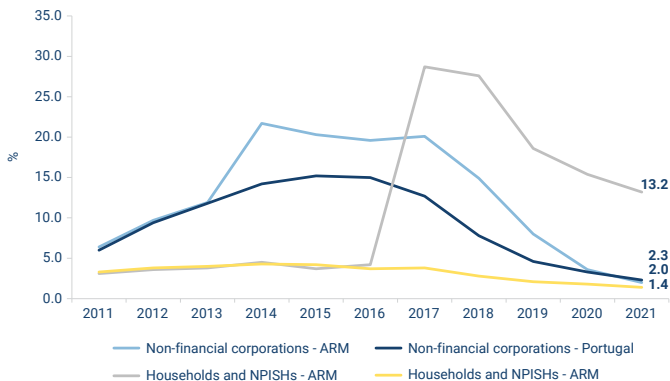

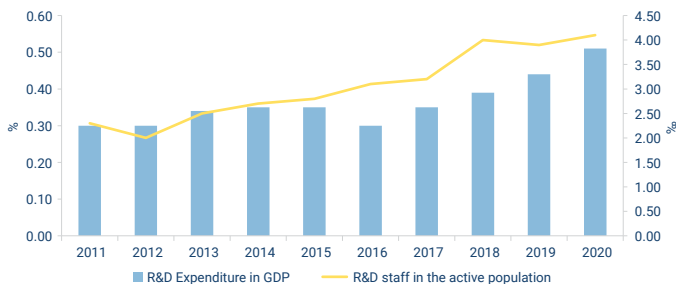

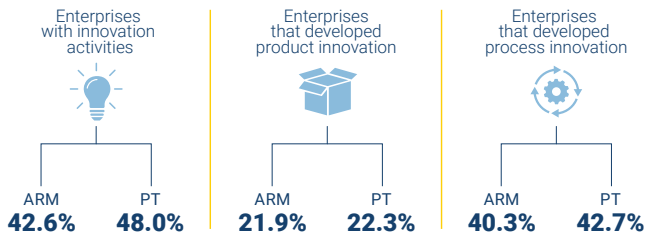

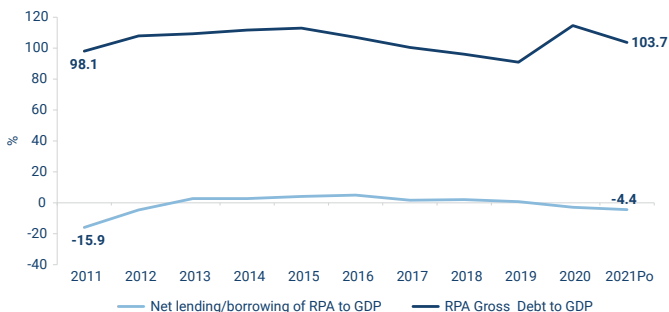

RATIO OF REGIONAL GOVERNMENT NET LENDING/BORROWING AND GROSS DEBT TO GDP, 2011-2021Po



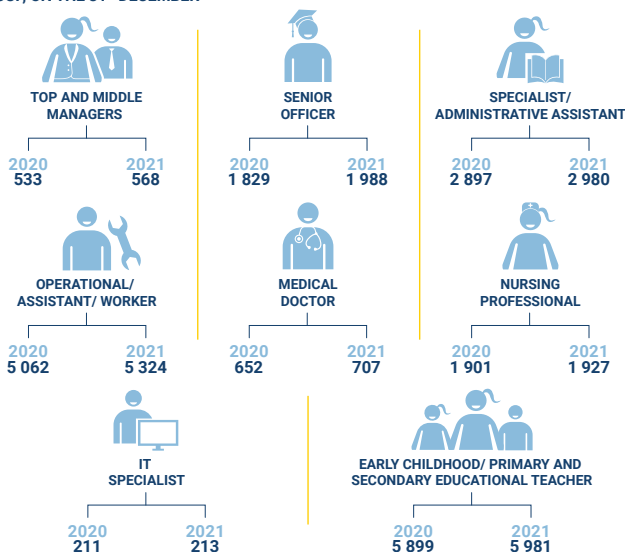
GROSS DEBT, 2021Po

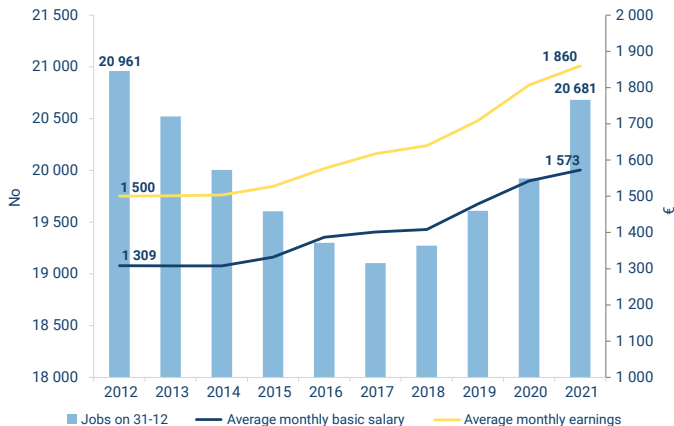

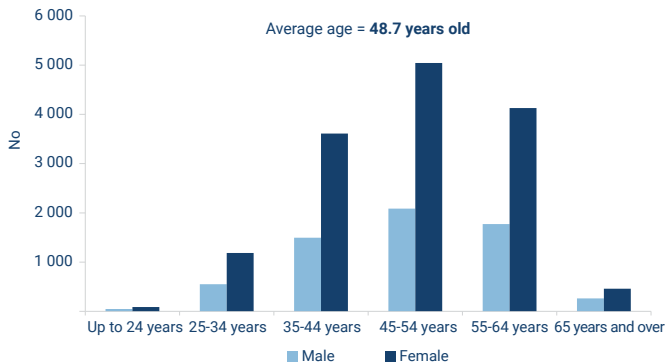

DISTRIBUTION OF JOBS BY AGE GROUP AND SEX ON THE 31st DECEMBER 2020

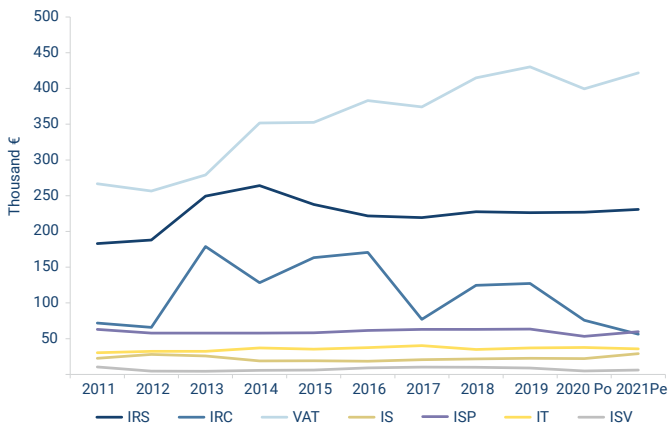

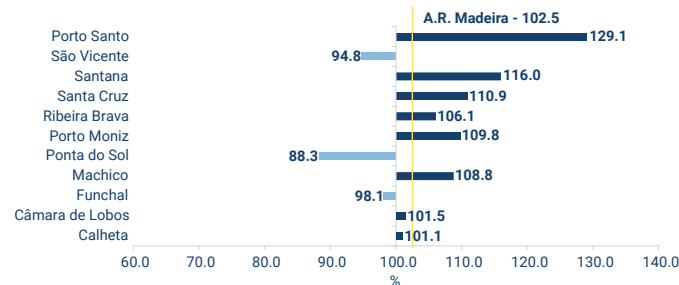

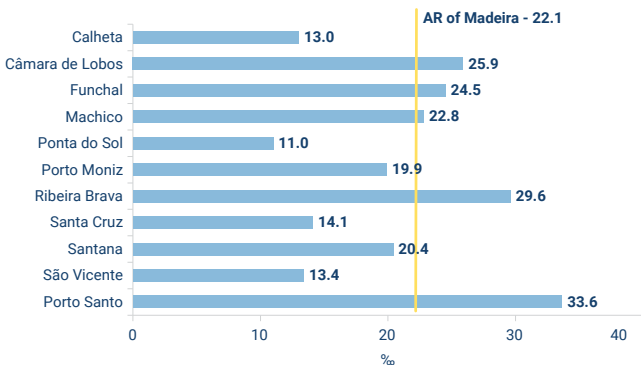

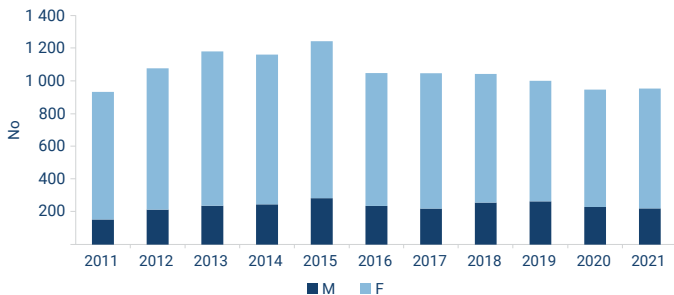

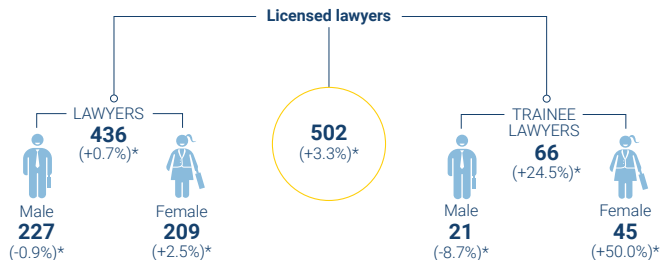
