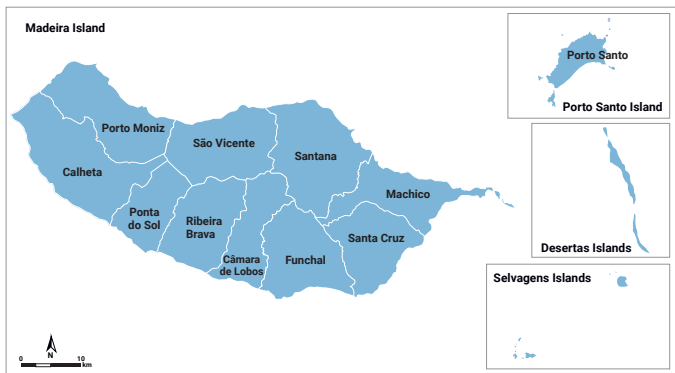
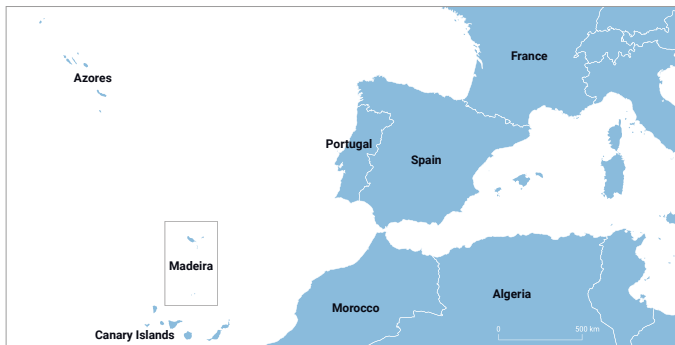

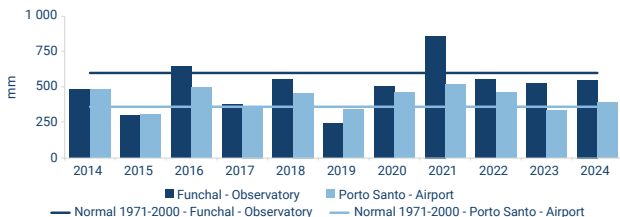

PRECIPITATION, BY METEOROLOGICAL STATION

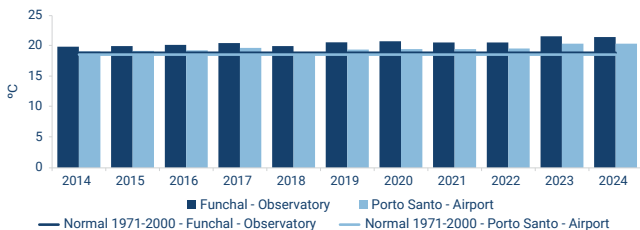

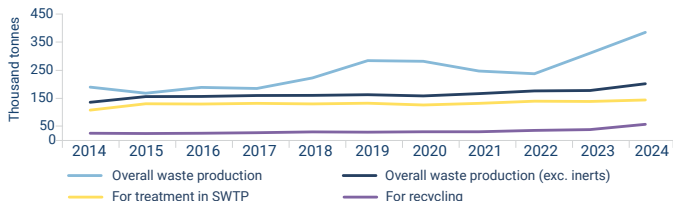

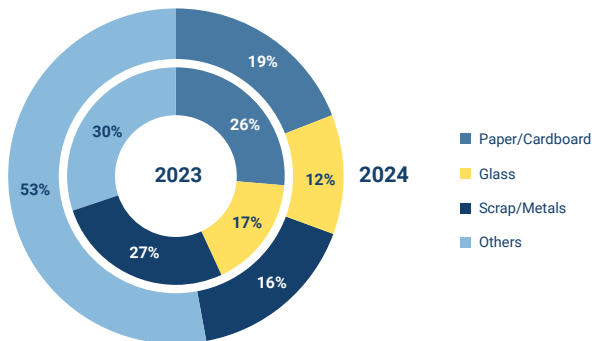

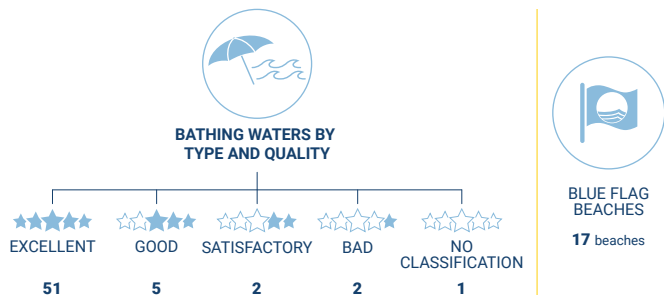

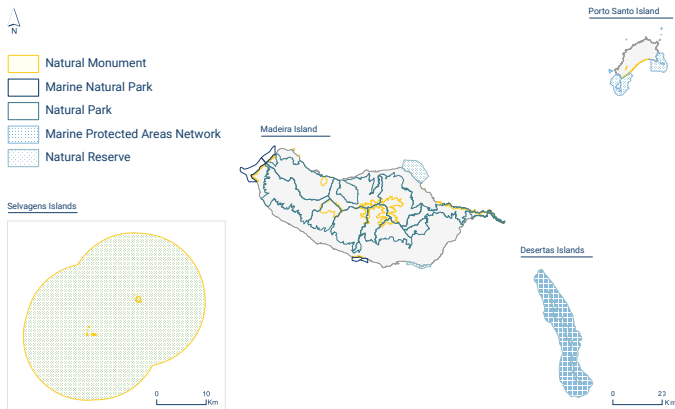

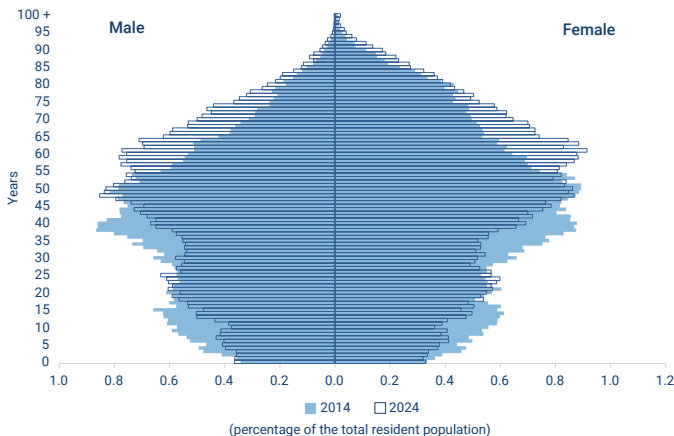

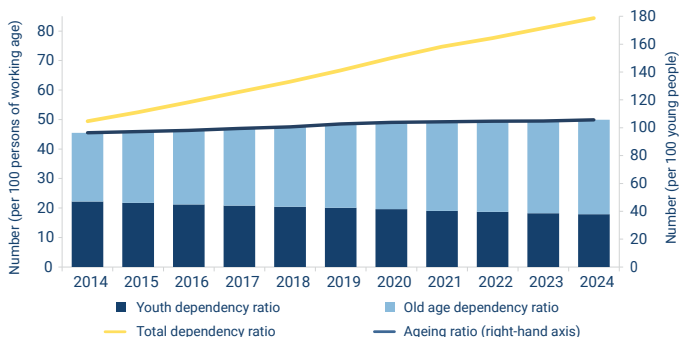

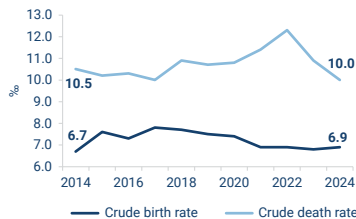
DEPENDENCY RATIO AND AGEING RATIO



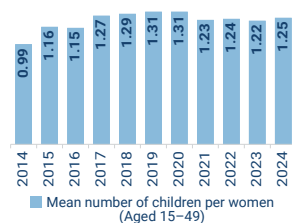

CRUDE BIRTH AND DEATH RATE

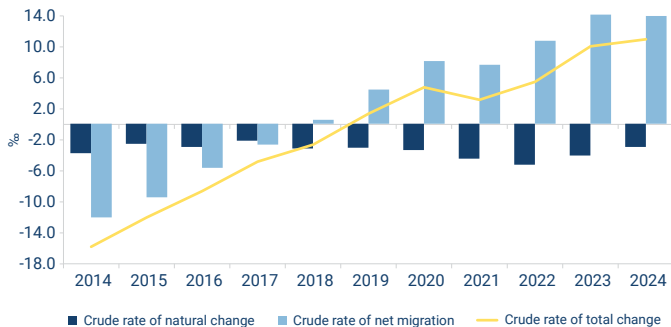


TOTAL FERTILITY RATE

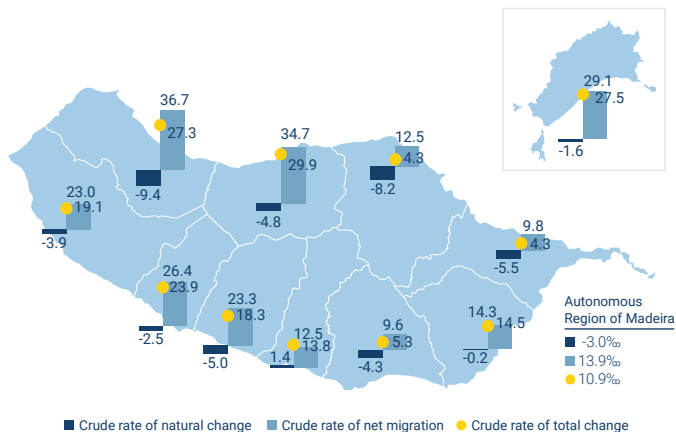

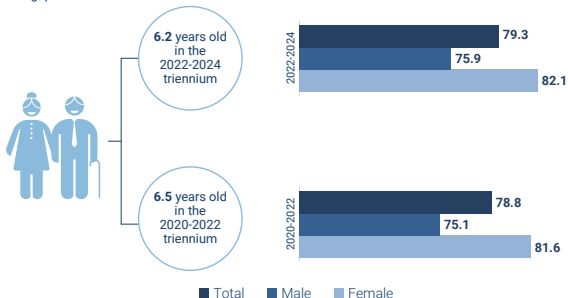

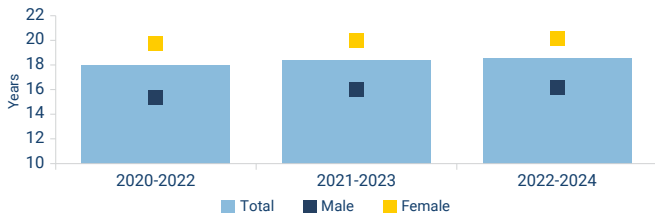

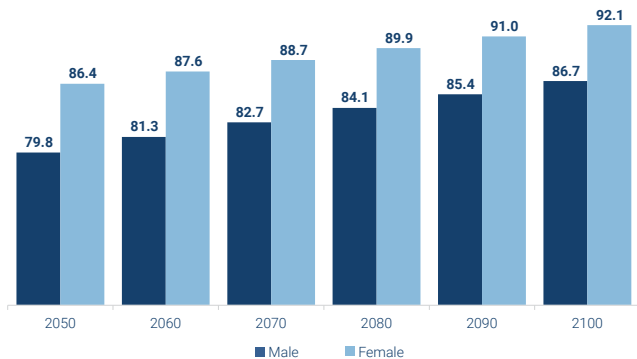

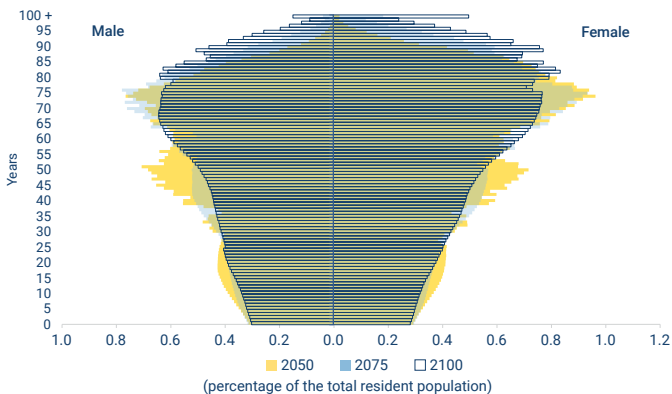

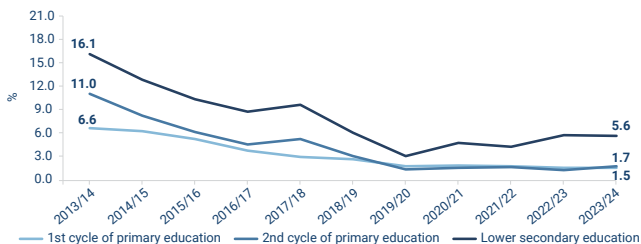

RETENTION AND DESISTANCE RATE AT PRIMARY AND LOWER SECONDARY EDUCATION LEVELS



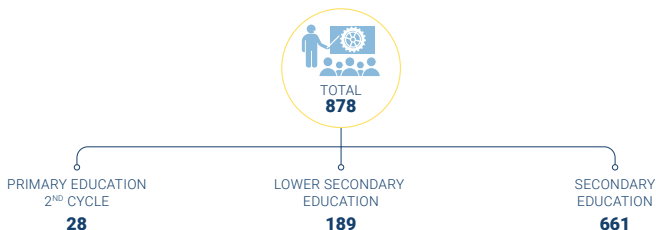

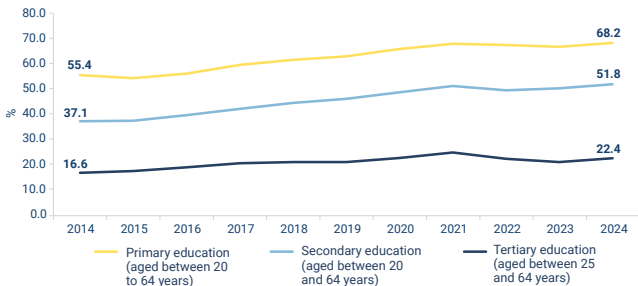

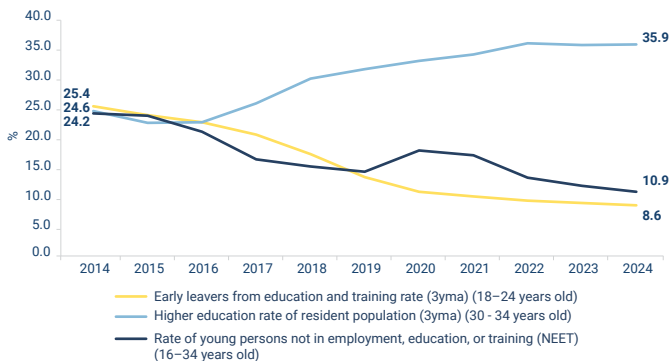

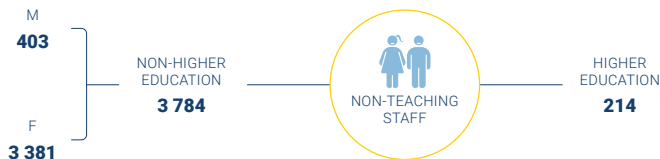

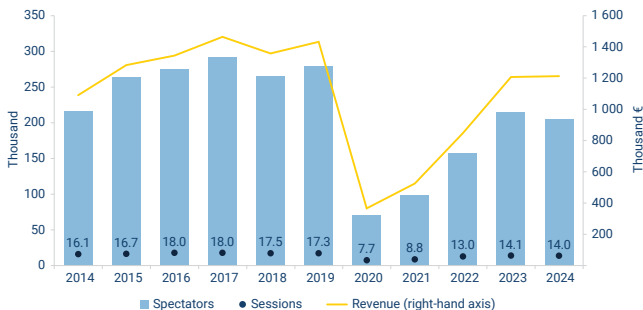

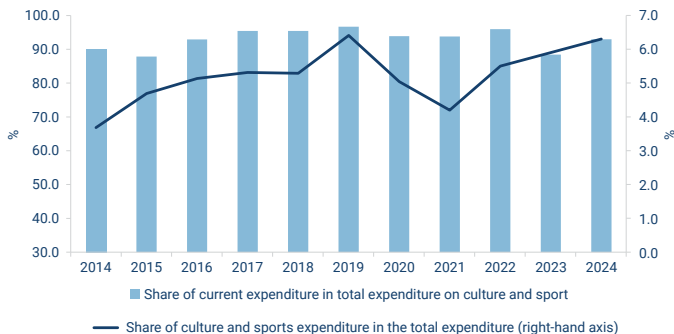

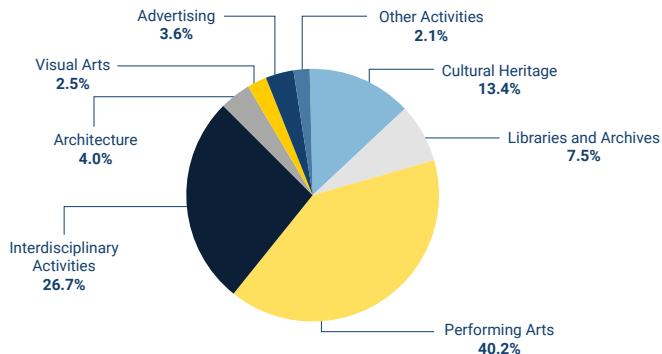

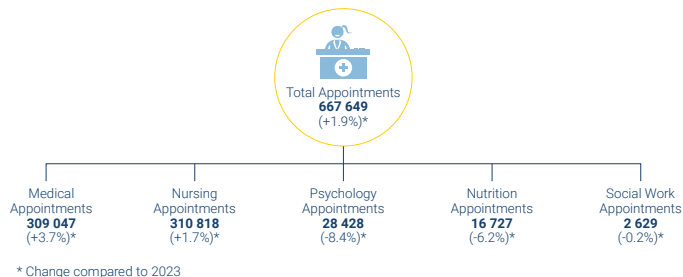

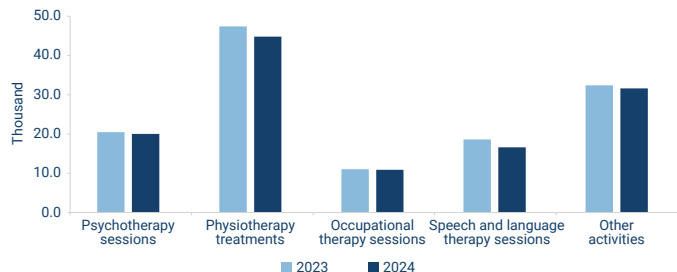

COMPLEMENTARY THERAPEUTIC PROCEDURES IN THE HEALTHCARE PRIMARY UNITS

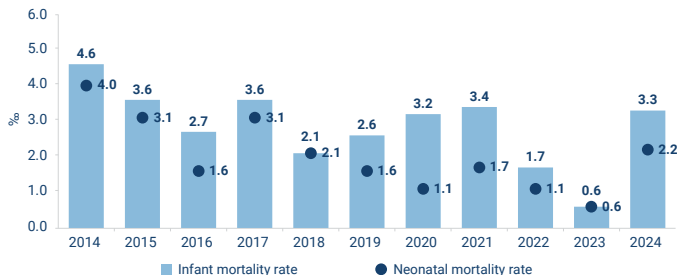

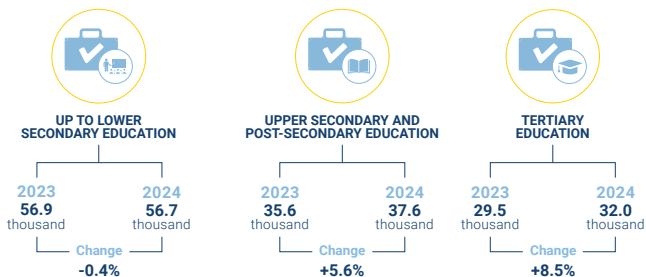

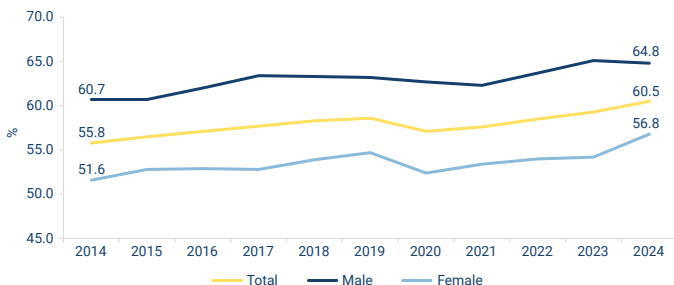

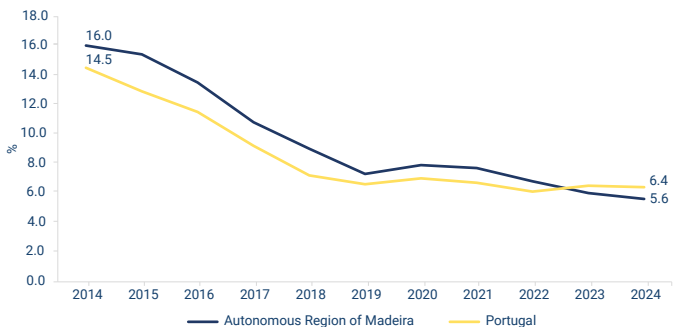

ACTIVITY RATE BY SEX

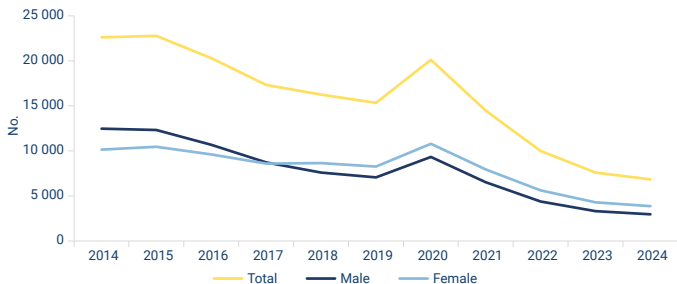


UNEMPLOYMENT RATE

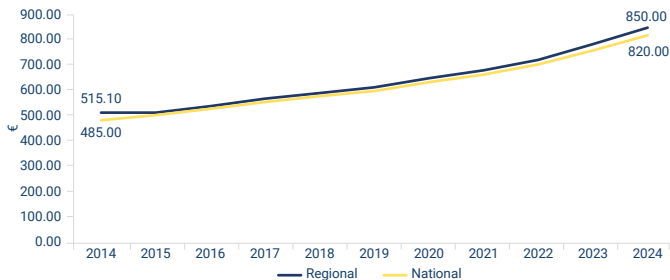

GUARANTEED MINIMUM MONTHLY WAGE

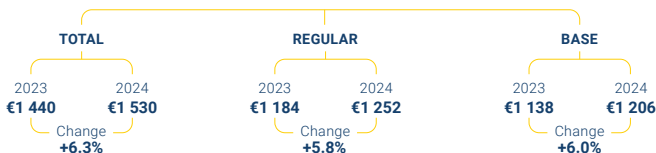

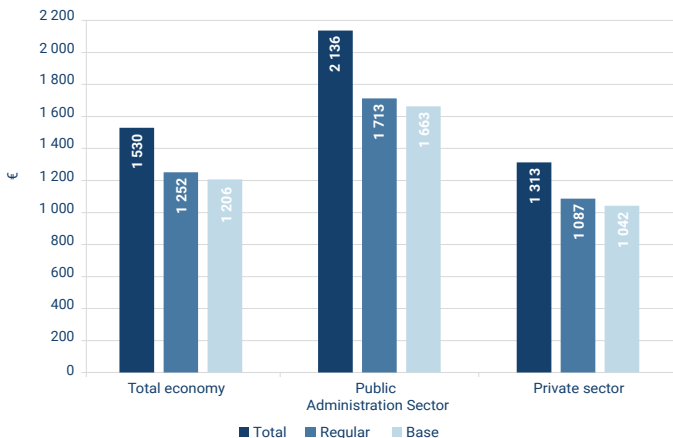
AVERAGE GROSS MONTHLY EARNINGS PER EMPLOYEE

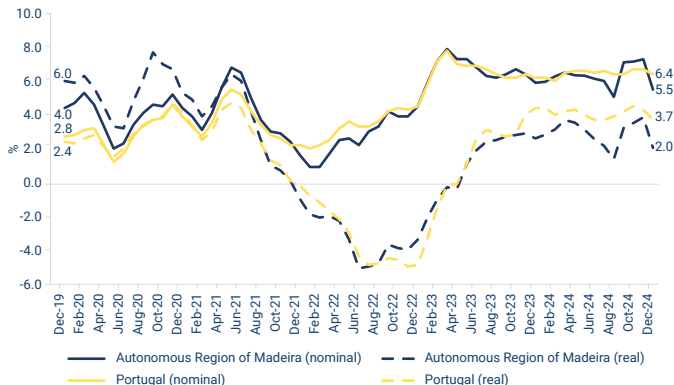

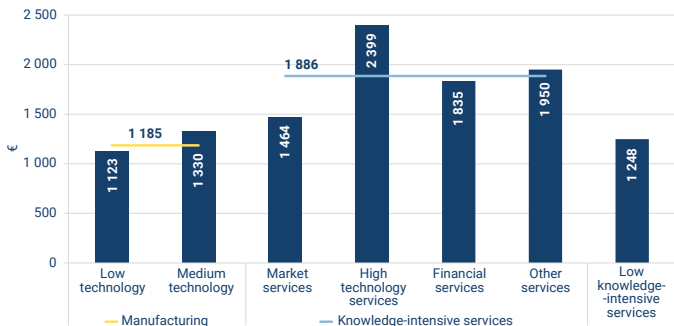

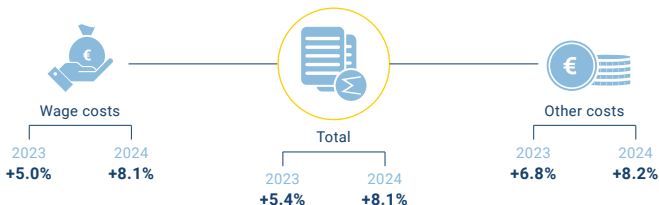

LABOUR COST INDEX (AVERAGE ANNUAL GROWTH RATE)

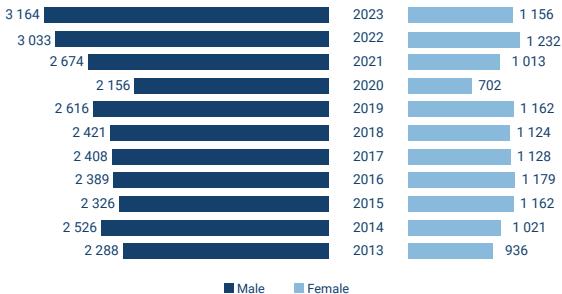

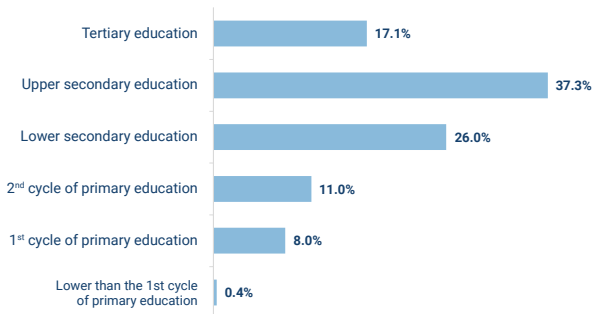

UNEMPLOYMENT AND SICKNESS BENEFITS FROM SOCIAL SECURITY, 2024



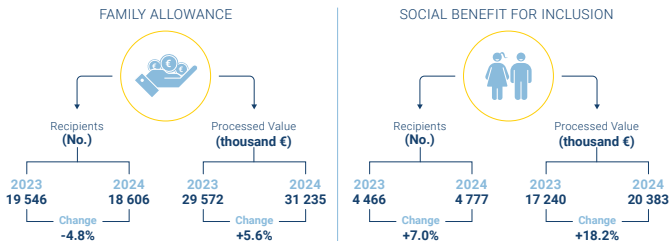

UNEMPLOYMENT BENEFIT RECIPIENTS BY AGE GROUP

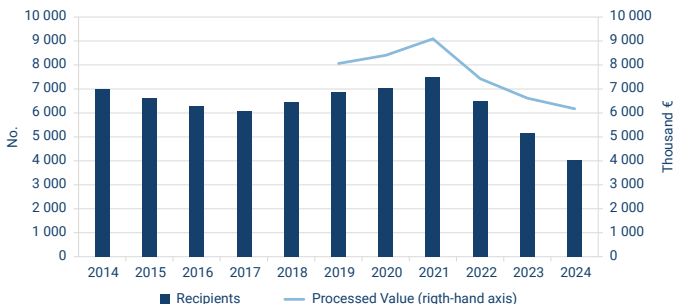

FAMILY ALLOWANCE AND SOCIAL BENEFIT FOR INCLUSION

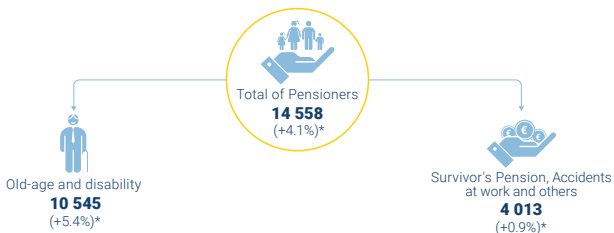


RECIPIENTS AND PROCESSED VALUE OF SOCIAL INTEGRATION INCOME

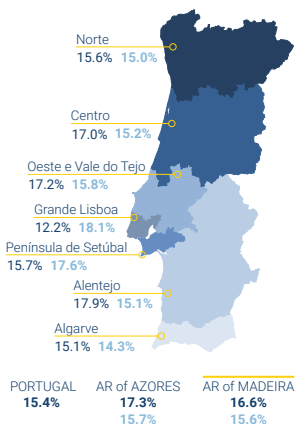

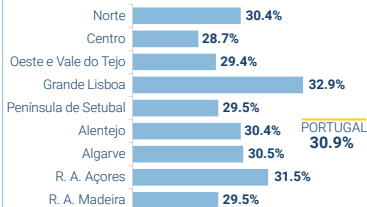

At-risk-of-poverty-rate, 2023

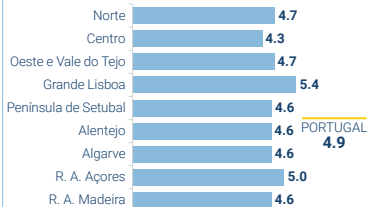

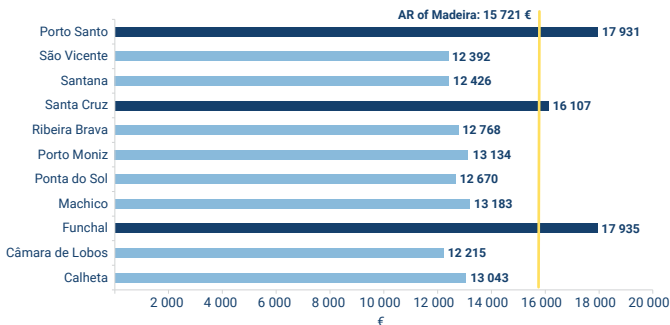

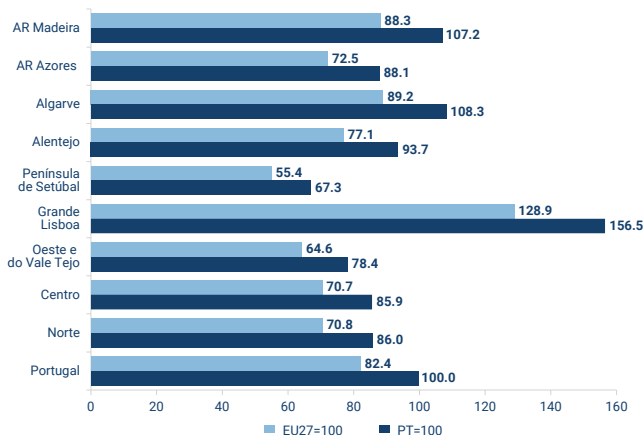

NON-FINANCIAL ENTERPRISES BY MUNICIPALITY, 2024



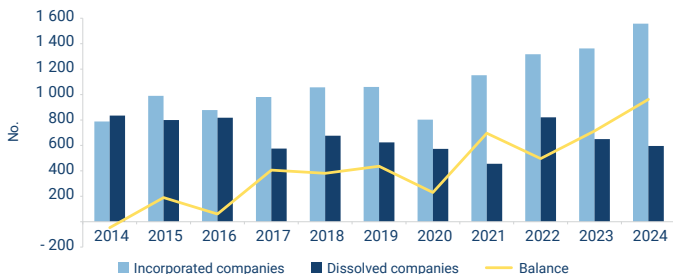

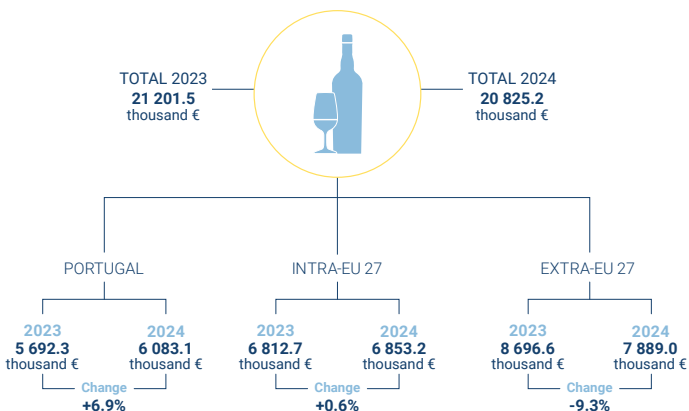

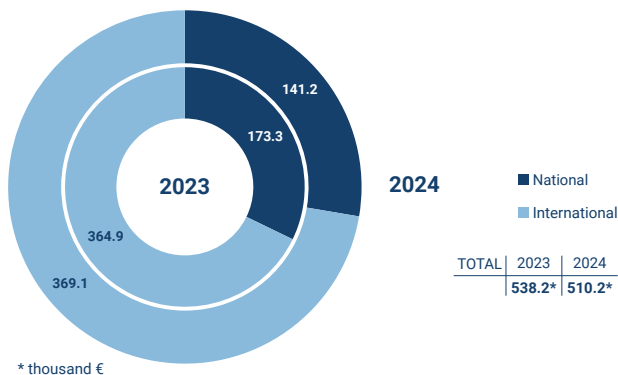

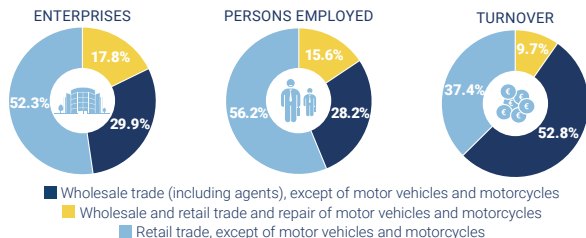

TOP SELLING PRODUCTS, BY PRODUCT GROUPS (CPA 2008), 2024

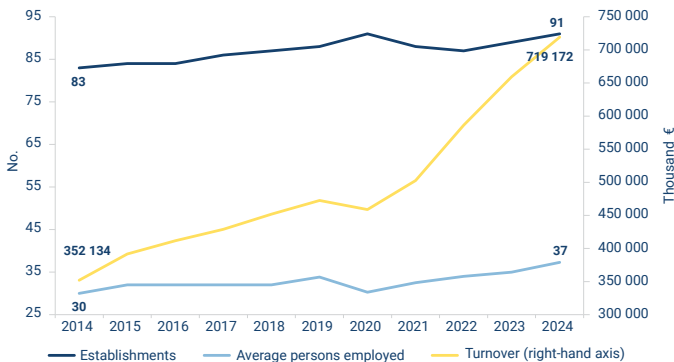

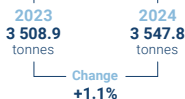

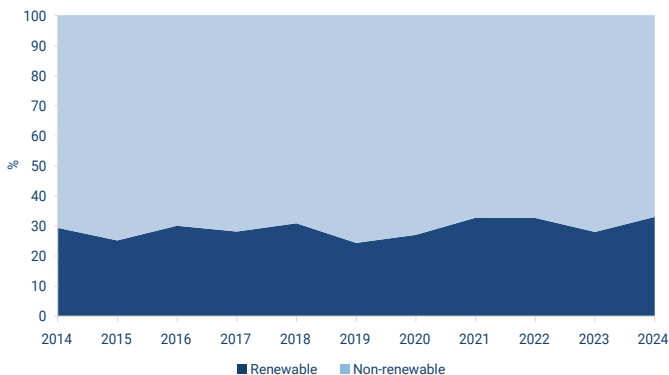

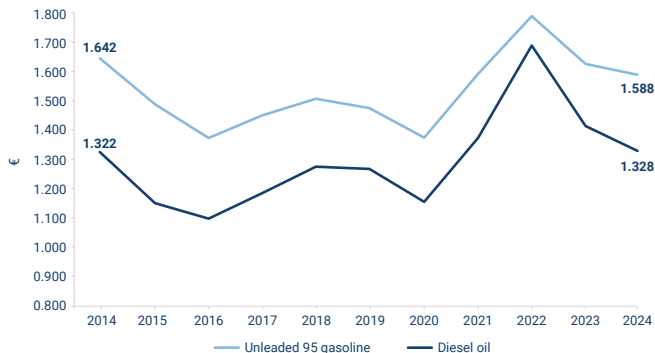

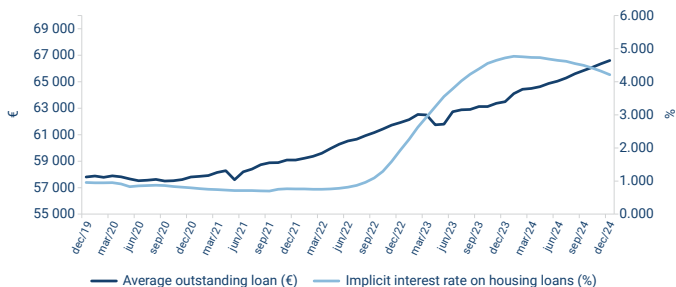

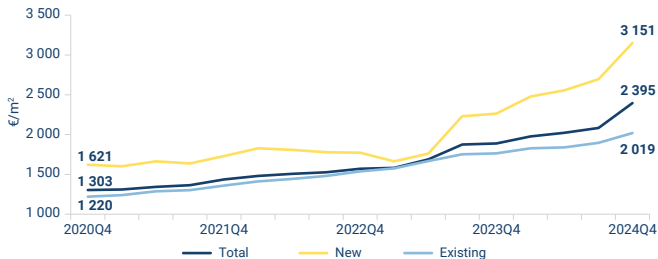

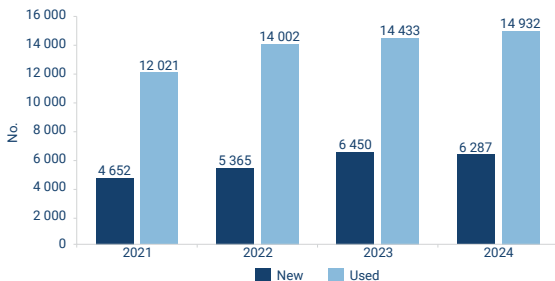

PASSENGERS TRANSPORTED BY BUS ACCORDING TO THE TYPE OF LINE



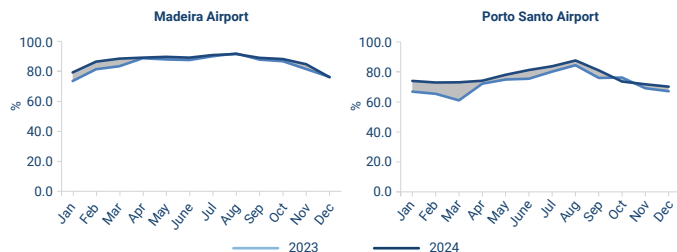

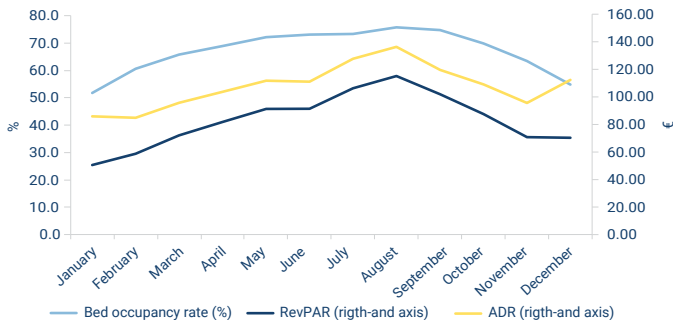

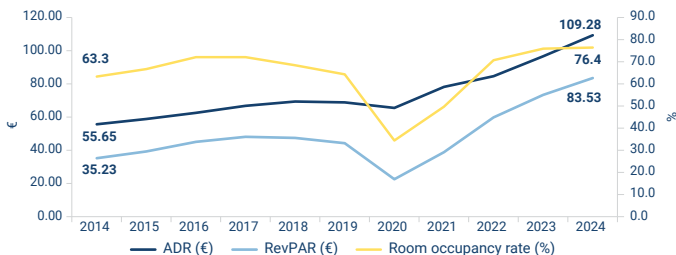

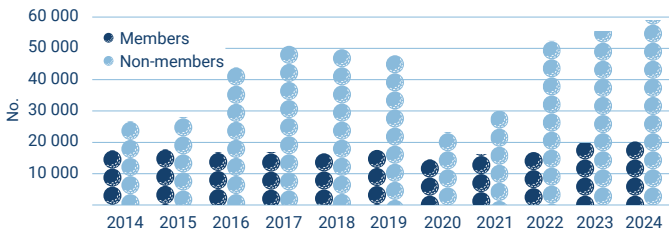

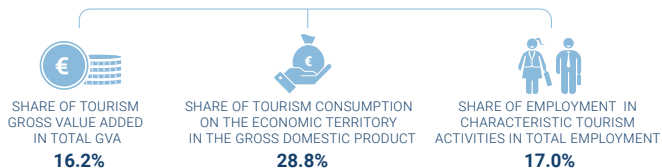

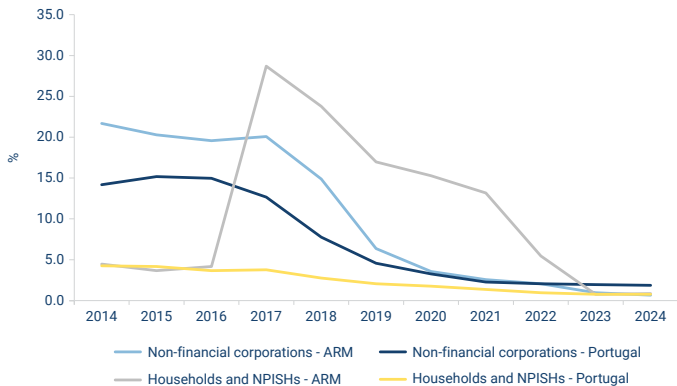

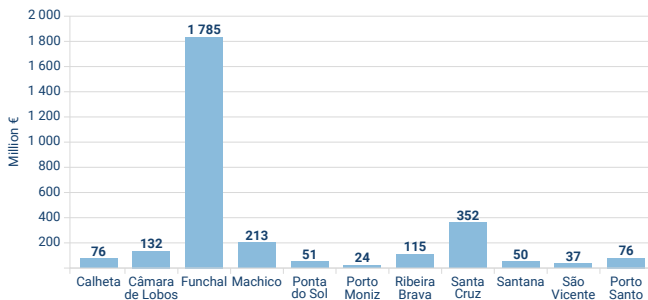

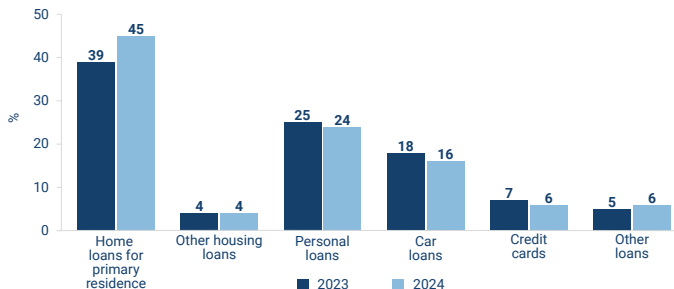

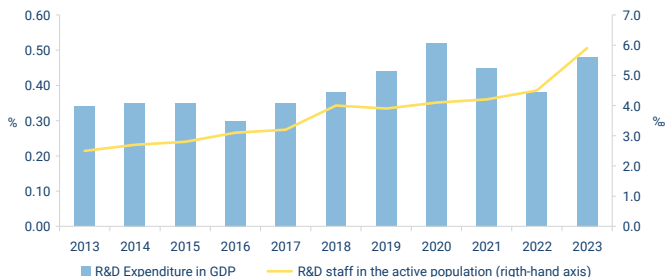

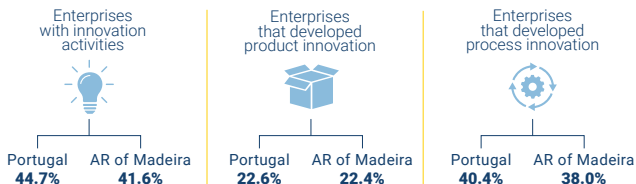

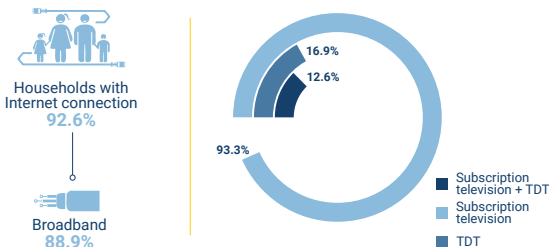

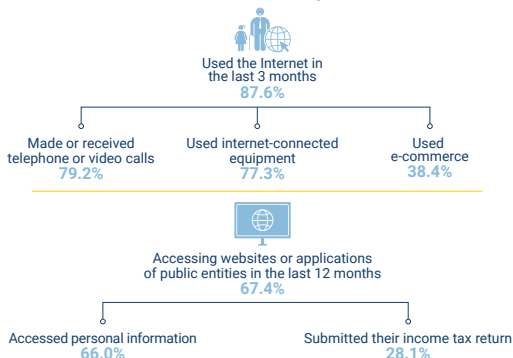

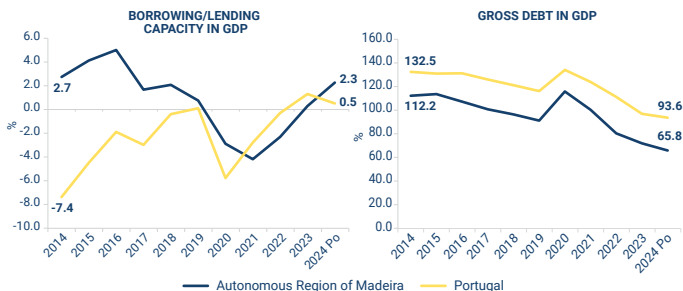

GROSS PUBLIC DEBT, 2024Po



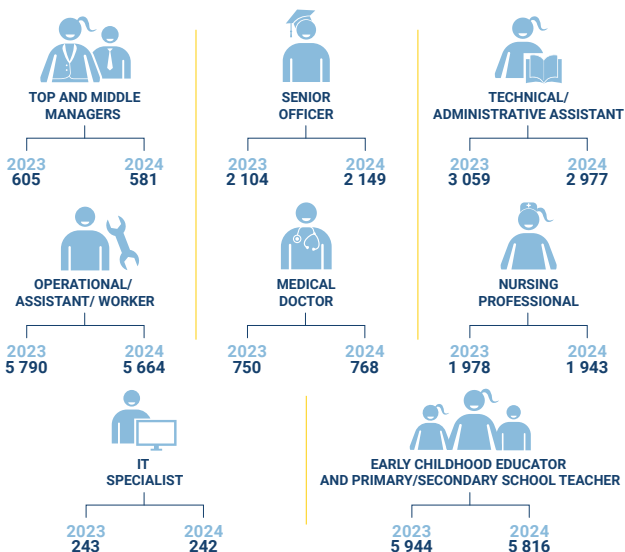

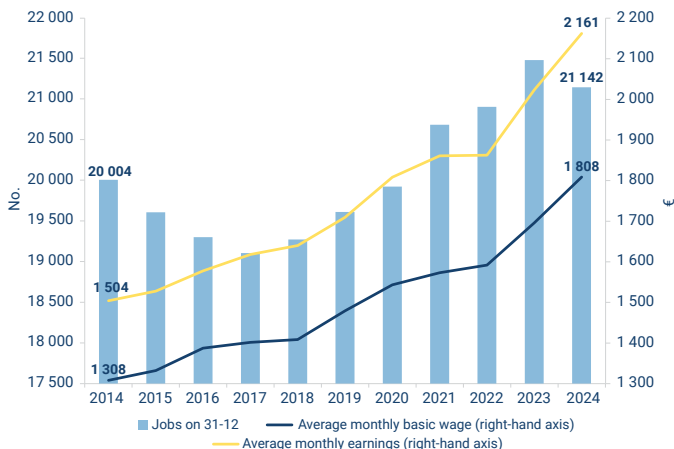

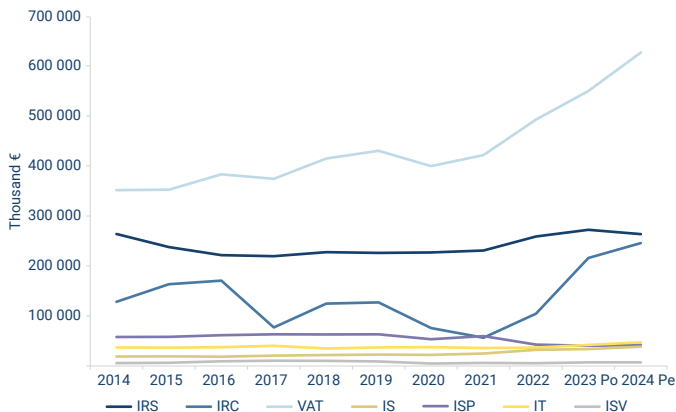

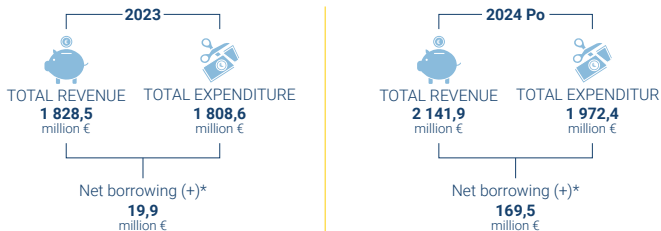

MAIN TAXES OF THE REGIONAL GOVERNMENT OF MADEIRA



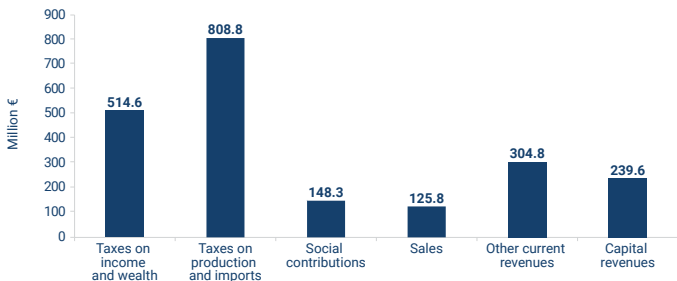

MAIN AGGREGATES OF THE REGIONAL GOVERNMENT OF MADEIRA

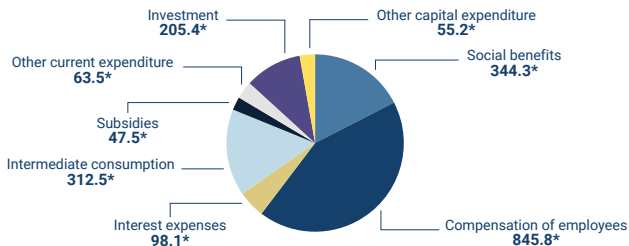

REVENUE OF THE REGIONAL GOVERNMENT OF MADEIRA BY ECONOMIC AGGREGATE, 2024Po



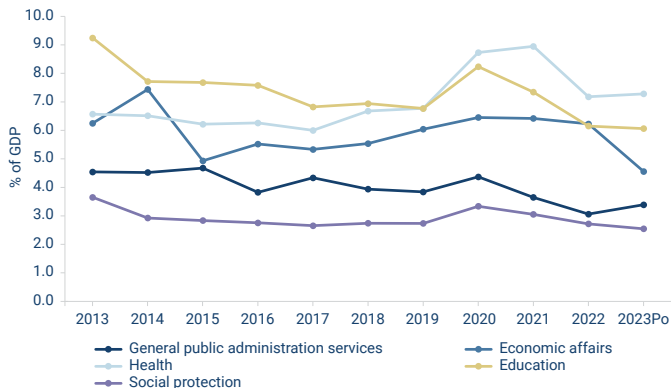
EXPENDITURE OF THE REGIONAL GOVERNMENT OF MADEIRA BY ECONOMIC AGGREGATE, 2024Po



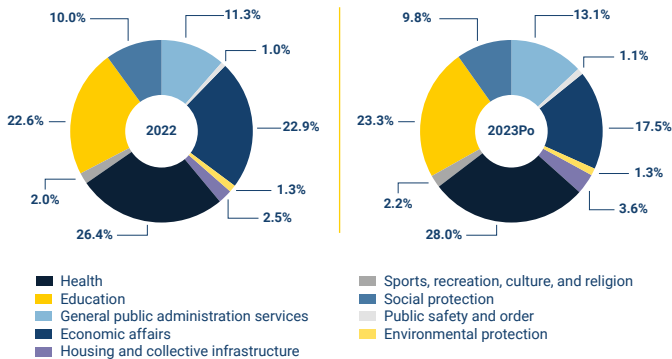

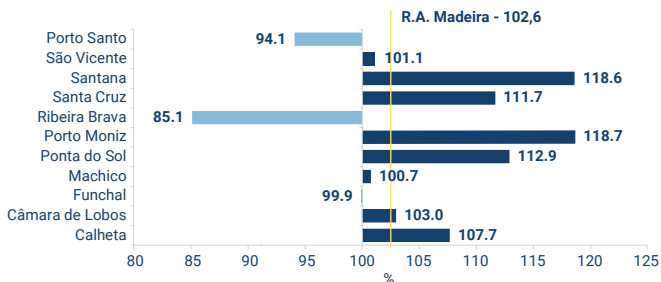

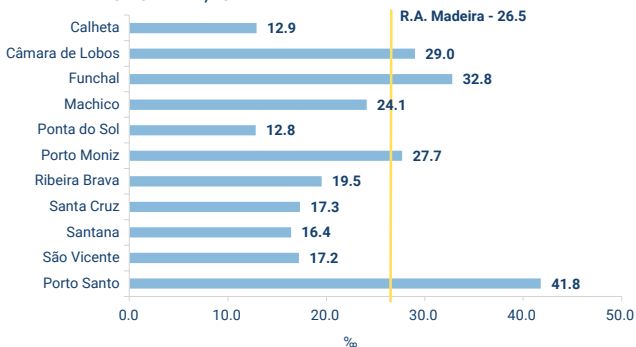

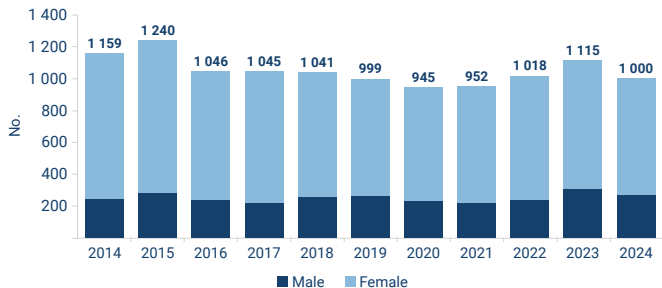

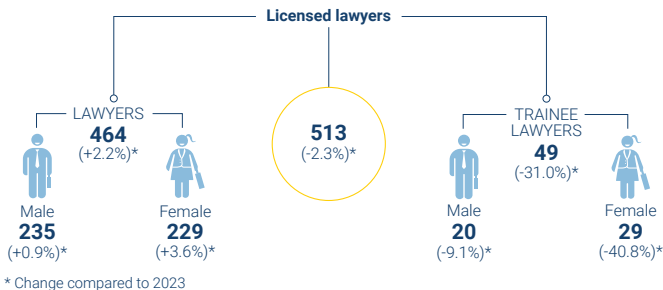

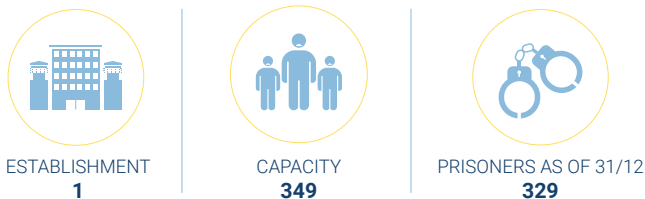

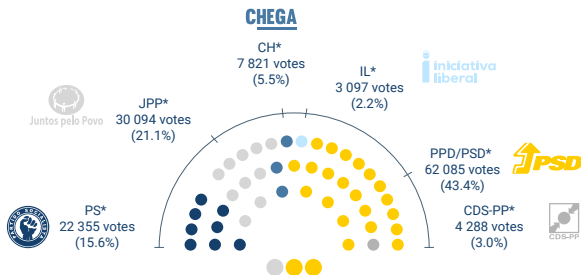

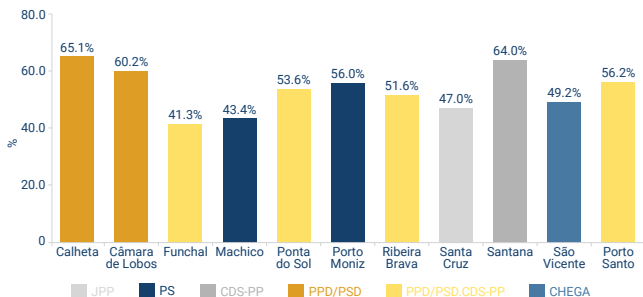

Territory

Climatological normal

Average value corresponding to a sequence of climatic values serialized per year and assumed to be representative of the predominant climatic value for the location under analysis. Note: for climatic data to be compatible and comparable worldwide, in 1872 the World Meteorological Organization (WMO) established 30-year periods as the standard for calculating averages of meteorological data.

Population density

Intensity of settlement expressed by the ratio between the number of inhabitants in a specific territorial area and the surface area of that territory (measured by the number of inhabitants per square kilometre).

Population

Ageing ratio

Ratio between the elderly population and the youth population, typically defined as the ratio between the number of persons aged 65 or older and the number of persons aged 0 to 14 (usually expressed per 100 persons aged 0 to 14).

Crude birth rate

Number of live births that occurred during a specific period, usually a calendar year, referred to the average population of that period (usually expressed as the number of live births per 1,000 inhabitants).

Crude death rate

Number of deaths observed during a specific period, usually a calendar year, referred to the average population of that period (usually expressed as the number of deaths per 1,000 inhabitants).

Crude migratory rate

Observed migration balance during a specific period, usually a calendar year, referred to the average population of that period (usually expressed per 100 or 1,000 inhabitants).

Crude rate of change

Population change observed during a specific period, usually a calendar year, referred to the average population of that period (usually expressed per 100 or 1,000 inhabitants).

Crude rate of natural change

Observed natural balance during a specific period, usually a calendar year, referred to the average population of that period (usually expressed per 100 or 1,000 inhabitants).

Migration balance

Difference between the number of entries and exits due to migration, whether international or internal, for a specific country or region, in a given period of time.

Natural change

Difference between live births and deaths.

Old age dependency ratio

Ratio between the elderly population and the population of working age, typically defined as the ratio between the number of persons aged 65 or older and the number of persons aged 15 to 64 (usually expressed per 100 persons aged 15-64).

Total fertility rate

Average number of live births per woman of childbearing age (15 to 49 years old), assuming that women are subject to the observed fertility rates at the time. It is the result of the sum of fertility rates by age, year by year or in five-year age groups, between the ages of 15 and 49, observed over a certain period (usually a civil year).

Youth dependency ratio

Ratio between the youth population and the population of working age, typically defined as the ratio between the number of persons aged 0 to 14 and the number of persons aged 15 to 64 (usually expressed per 100 persons aged 15-64).

Education**Enrolment rate**

Ratio between the resident population aged 20 to 64 with at least a certain level of completed education and the resident population aged 20 to 64. In the case of the tertiary education enrolment rate, the age range is between 25 and 64 years (usually expressed as a percentage).

Formal education

Intentional, institutionalised, and planned education materialised in the provision of education and training, granting school certification or double certification, presenting a progressive succession of levels of education, and delivered by public or private entities recognised by the competent national authorities in education and training matters.

Non-formal education

Intentional, institutionalised, and planned education that constitutes an addition and/or a complement to formal education in the context of lifelong learning, granting a certificate of attendance but not a level of education.

Early school leaving rate

The ratio between the resident population aged 18 to 24, with education up to the lower secondary education, who did not receive any form of education (formal or non-formal) during the reference period, and the resident population aged 18 to 24 years (usually expressed as a percentage).

Health

Infant mortality rate

Number of deaths of children under 1 year old observed during a specific period, usually a calendar year, referred to the number of live births in the same period (usually expressed as the number of deaths of children under 1 year per 1,000 live births).

Neonatal mortality rate

Number of deaths of children under 28 days old observed during a specific period, usually a calendar year, referred to the number of live births in the same period (usually expressed as the number of deaths of children under 28 days old per 1,000 live births).

Labour Market

Active person

Person aged 16 to 89 years who, in the reference period, who was part of the available workforce for the production of goods and services that enter the economic circuit (was employed or unemployed).

Activity rate

Rate that defines the relationship between the active population and the resident population of working age.

Base gross earnings

Gross amount (before any deductions) in cash and/or in kind, paid regularly and guaranteed to the worker in the reference period and corresponding to the normal working period.

Earnings

Gross amount in cash and/or in kind, paid to the worker, regularly related to the reference period, for time worked or work provided in the normal and extraordinary period. It also includes the payment of paid but not worked hours (vacations, holidays, and other paid absences) and regular subsidies, such as food, function, housing or transportation subsidies, seniority or seniority premiums, productivity, attendance, and exemption from working hours, or strenuous, dangerous, dirty, shift, and night work.

Employed person

Person aged 16 to 89 years who, in the reference period, who was in one of the following situations: performed work for at least one hour, with a view to payment of remuneration or benefit, in cash or in kind (including unpaid family work); had a formal connection to a job or work but was not temporarily at work; was in a pre-retirement situation but working.

Employment rate

Rate that allows defining the ratio between the employed population and the population of working age.

Gross earnings

Earnings, in cash or in kind, paid to workers for hours worked or work performed in the normal and extraordinary period, including the payment of paid but not worked hours (vacations, holidays, and other paid absences) and regular subsidies such as food, function, housing or transportation subsidies, seniority or seniority premiums, productivity, attendance, and exemption from working hours, or strenuous, dangerous, dirty, shift, and night work.

Inactive person

Person aged under 16 years, over 89 years, or aged 16 to 89 years who, in the reference period, could not be considered active, i.e., was not employed or unemployed.

Regular gross earnings

Monthly gross earnings that correspond to the sum of the base remuneration with other regular remuneration components, namely food subsidies, seniority or seniority premiums, bonuses, bonuses, and other regular monthly benefits.

Unemployed person

Person aged 16 to 74 years who, in the reference period, who was simultaneously in the following situations: had no paid work or any other; actively sought employment, paid or unpaid, over a specific period (in the reference period or the previous three weeks); was available to work in paid or unpaid employment.

Unemployment rate

Rate that defines the relationship between the unemployed population and the active population.

Income and Living Conditions**At-risk poverty rate**

Proportion of the population whose equivalent income is below the poverty line, defined as 60% of the median equivalised disposable income.

Gini coefficient

Indicator of inequality in income distribution that aims to synthesize in a single value the asymmetry of this distribution. It takes values between 0 (when all persons have equal income) and 100 (when all income is concentrated in a single person).

Gross reported income

Income that corresponds to: 1) the value of non-exempt income before any specific deductions for categories A (Dependent Employment) and H (Pensions); 2) the value of net income, i.e., the value of income after the respective specific deductions, for the remaining categories.

Personnel income paid tax (IRS)

Value of the tax corresponding to the due tax, i.e., the net collection of deductions provided for in the IRS code and tax benefits, before deducting withholding taxes and on-account payments.

Poverty threshold

Income threshold below which a family is considered at risk of poverty. This value was conventionally set by the European Commission as 60% of the median income per equivalent adult in each country (also applicable to a region).

S80/S20 ratio

Indicator of inequality in income distribution, defined as the ratio between the proportion of total income received by the top 20% of the population and the share of income earned by the bottom 20%.

Severe material and social deprivation rate

Proportion of the population experiencing at least seven out of thirteen difficulties.

Very low per capita labour intensity (Europe 2030)

It is considered to be very low per capita labour intensity persons under 65 years of age who, in the income reference period, lived in households where the adult population aged 18 to 64 reported working, on average, less than 20% of the possible working time (excluding students aged 18 to 24; retirees and/or pensioners of old age or disability; and inactive persons aged 60-64 living in households whose main source of income is pensions).

Regional Accounts**Apparent labour productivity (GVA/total employment)**

GVA of the region or sector / Total employment of the region or sector.

Gross fixed capital formation

Macroeconomic indicator consisting of the acquisitions of fixed assets, net of disposals, made by resident producers during a given period, and certain additions to the value of non-produced assets, obtained through the productive activity of production or institutional units. Fixed assets are produced assets used in production for more than one year.

Gross value added (GVA)

Value created by any unit involved in a productive activity, corresponding to the balance of the production account, which includes, as resources, production, and as uses, intermediate consumption, before deducting capital consumption.

Regional GDP disparity index (EU27=100)

GDP per capita in Purchasing Power Parity (PPP) of the region / GDP per capita in PPP of the EU27 x 100.

Regional GDP disparity index (Portugal=100)

Region's GDP per capita / Portugal's GDP per capita x 100.

Regional gross domestic product (GDP)

Gross domestic product evaluated at market prices, corresponding to the sum of gross value added at basic prices, net of taxes on products and subsidies, to products and imports, by region. The sum of regional GDP at market prices, including the extra regional territory's GDP, is equal to GDP at market prices.

Trade**Import coverage rate**

(Exports / Imports) x 100.

Large-Sized Commercial Unit

Establishment, considered individually or as part of a set belonging to the same enterprise or group of enterprises, where commercial activity is carried out and which meets the conditions:

- If it is a food or mixed retail trade, it has a continuous selling area (AEV) $\geq 2,000$ m²;
- If it is a non-food retail trade, it has a continuous selling area (AEV) $\geq 4,000$ m²;
- If it is a food or mixed retail trade, belonging to an enterprise or group of enterprises that owns an accumulated AEV of food retail trade $\geq 15,000$ m²;
- If it is a non-food retail trade, belonging to an enterprise or group that owns an accumulated AEV $\geq 25,000$ m².

Trade balance

Difference between exports and imports.

Agriculture**Agricultural holdings**

Technical-economic unit that uses its own labour and production factors and must necessarily meet the following four conditions: a) produce one or more agricultural products; b) reach or exceed a certain size (area, number of animals, etc.); c) be subject to a unique management; d) be located in a specific and identifiable place.

Arable land

Cultivated land intended for plant production, land taken out of production, and land occupied by greenhouses or covered by fixed or mobile structures.

Family farm population

Set of persons who are part of the producer's household (singular), whether or not they work on the farm, as well as other family members who, not belonging to the household, regularly participate in the agricultural work of the farm.

Kitchen garden

Area usually with less than 5 ares, reserved for the cultivation of products such as vegetables, fruits, and flowers primarily for self-consumption and not for sale.

Permanent crops

Crops that occupy the land for an extended period and provide repeated harvests, not entering into crop rotations. They do not include permanent grassland and meadows.

Permanent grassland

Set of sown or spontaneous plants, generally herbaceous, intended to be eaten by livestock on the spot where they grow, but which may also be cut at certain times of the year. They are not included in a rotation and occupy the soil for a period exceeding 5 years.

Utilised agricultural area (UAA)

Area of the farm that includes arable land (clean and under forest cover), kitchen garden, permanent crops, and permanent grassland.

Tourism**Average daily rate (ADR)**

Indicator that reflects the ratio between revenue from accommodation and the number of rooms used, in the reference period.

Average length of stay in the establishment

Ratio between the number of nights and the number of guests that gave rise to those nights, in the reference period, from the supply perspective.

Net bed-occupancy rate

Ratio between the number of overnight stays and the number of beds available in the reference period, considering double beds as two.

Net bedroom-occupancy rate

Ratio between the number of rooms occupied and the number of rooms available in the reference period.

Overnight stay

Stay of a person in an establishment that provides accommodation, for a period between 12 hours of one day and 12 hours of the next day.

Revenue from accommodation

Amount charged for overnight stays by all guests in tourist accommodation.

Revenue per available room (RevPAR)

Indicator that reflects the ratio between revenue from accommodation and the number of available rooms, in the reference period.

Monetary and Financial Sector**Overdue loans ratio**

Corresponds to the ratio between the “end-of-period” value of loans repayment and the “end-of-period” value of loans granted.

Science and Technology**Full-time equivalent (FTE)**

Total effective time dedicated by staff to a particular activity, either full-time or part-time.

Innovation activities

Activities aimed at developing innovation in products or processes, which may involve the allocation of resources and specific commitment to strategies, methods, and procedures.

Innovation activities in the enterprise

Innovation activities pursued in the development, financing, and trade that cover the following areas: research and development (R&D), engineering, design, or other creative activities, marketing, and activities related to brand value, intellectual property rights, personnel training, software development, and database management, acquisition or rental of tangible assets, and management of innovation activities.

R&D expenditure as a percentage of GDP

Total R&D expenses / GDP x 100.

Research and development (R&D)

All creative work pursued systematically to broaden the set of knowledge, including knowledge of man, culture, and society, as well as the use of this set of knowledge in new applications.

Regional Public Administration**Gross Public Debt (Maastricht definition)**

Includes cash and deposits held with public administrations (such as savings certificates or Treasury), debt securities issued by public administrations (including, among others, bonds and Treasury bills), and loans obtained by these entities.

Net lending/net borrowing of Public Administrations

By definition, in a non-financial perspective, the difference between revenues (resources) and expenses (uses) constitutes the net lending (+)/borrowing (-) of the institutional sector of Public Administrations, also called the budget balance.

Justice**Crime rate**

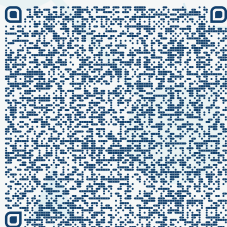
(Number of crimes / resident population) x 1,000.

Political participation**Proportion of votes for the most-voted Party/Coalition**

Votes for the most-voted Party/Coalition / Total votes x 100

Voter abstention rate

(Abstention / Registered voters) x 100
