Notes:

Still intended - Number of biological children that people still intend to have in the future (including current pregnancy, if applicable).

Actual+still intended - Number of biological children (born alive) that people ever had plus the number of children that people intend to have in the future (including current pregnancy, if applicable).

Ultimately intended - Number of biological children that people intend to have throughout their lives, regardless of those they already have and regardless of those they intend to have.

Ideal number of children in a family - number of children (biological, adopted, stepchildren or other) considered by people as ideal for a family, regardless of being its own family.
