- The dwellings where the households and persons will be surveyed are randomly selected through rigorous statistical methods that ensure the representativeness of the sample.
- In any of the methods of collecting data (phone, internet or face-to-face), the surveyed entities are informed in advance, by letter, about the survey's operation, the sample selection, the topic and objectives, the period during which data will be collected, etc. The letter also provides the necessary elements to ensure/test the trustworthiness of the source.
- The Statistics Portugal/Regional Directorate of Statistics of Madeira interviewers are duly identified through a card/license for face-to-face interviews, being available also other secure means to prove their identification when doing data collection by telephone.
